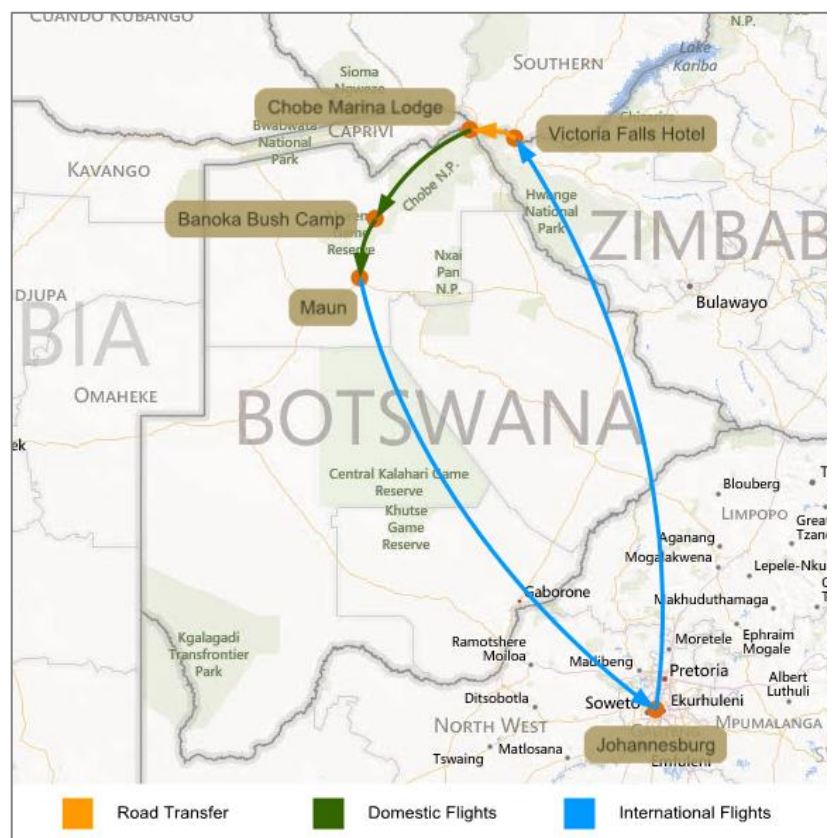

CANCELLATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- ▶ All cancellations must be advised of in writing
Cancellation penalties:
- ▶ For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
- ▶ For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
- ▶ For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)

INSURANCE

- ▶ African Ubuntu Safaris strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans
- ▶ African Ubuntu Safaris will not be liable for any costs resulting from any traveller's failure to purchase sufficient travel insurance

LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS ON LIGHT AIRCRAFT

Many itineraries include light aircraft flights. Please note that these flights have very strict luggage restrictions. Please take note of the following:

Southern Africa:

- ▶ Only **completely soft sided bags** are accepted. The bags can have no frames with wheels, even if the rest of the bag is soft.
- ▶ The weight limit is **20 kg per person**. This **includes hand luggage**.
- ▶ Extra weight allowance can be purchased in advance.

If your bags do not fit the requirements, you may be asked to purchase a suitable bag from the airline and repack your belongings into this.

DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1**03 Aug 2014****Arrive in Victoria Falls**

At **13h05** on arrival today on flight **BA6285 (booked by you)** at Victoria Falls Airport you will be met after entry procedures and transferred to the **Victoria Falls Hotel** where you will spend the next **2 nights** on a **bed and breakfast basis**. At **14h30** you will be taken on a guided tour of the Falls and at **18h50** you will be taken to the Boma Restaurant for an entertaining African dinner, complete with drums and dancing.

Arrive: 03 Aug 2014 | Depart: 05 Aug 2014**2 nights (breakfast)**

Victoria Falls Hotel

The Edwardian-style 5 star hotel, built in 1904, redecorated and refurbished, now combines the charm of the old with the convenience of the new. The ambiance of the hotel is steeped in history with all suites decorated in the gracious Edwardian style of Zimbabwe's colonial era. The Hotel has seen reigning monarchs, presidents and, more recently, many famous Hollywood stars among its privileged occupants.



Victoria Falls

"Mosi Oa Tunya", or "The Smoke That Thunders", Victoria Falls are as magnificent on the 10th visit as they are on the 1st, and their thundering roar makes everything else seem strangely quiet once you leave them behind. As the mighty Zambezi flows over a chasm of 1 mile wide, and 110 metres high, to violently crash on the rocks below, the resultant spray is sent tens of metres up into the air, before it lands back down in a continuous rainfall. The water then rushes through an opening of only 50 metres, as the Zambezi races further along, over churning rapids and through the deep Batoka Gorge. While the Falls are the major drawcard, there is a thriving tourist industry developed around them, with adventure activities of all forms being available.



Day 2	04 Aug 2014	Victoria Falls
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You will have the full day today to take part in some of the many option activities, before being taken at **16h00** on a sunset cruise on the mighty Zambezi River.

Day 3	05 Aug 2014	Victoria Falls ~ Chobe National Park
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This morning at **10h00** you will be collected from your hotel and transferred across the border into Botswana. You will be taken to the town of Kasane to spend the next **2 nights** at **Chobe Marina Lodge** on a **full board basis**. During your stay here, 4 game viewing activities are included, made up of game drives inside Chobe National Park and boat cruises on the Chobe River.

Arrive: 05 Aug 2014 | Depart: 07 Aug 2014 **2 nights (all meals)**



Chobe Marina Lodge

Located in Kasane, on the banks of the Chobe River, Chobe Marina Lodge provides accommodation in 60 rooms made up of studios, apartments, chalets, or suites with private lounges. All include the modern comforts of air-conditioning, television, telephones, mini bars and daily housekeeping. Dining experiences at the lodge include the a la carte Commissioners Restaurant, the more informal Mokoros Restaurant, and a pool bar and riverside bar overlooking the Chobe river.

Chobe National Park

With an enormous elephant population, as well as magnificent birdlife and a huge array of herbivores and aquatic animals, it is often hard to believe that Chobe National Park is for real. The game viewing starts from the moment you land at Kasane Airport, or drive across the border from Zambia or Zimbabwe, with warthogs foraging in the streets, buffalo being habitual visitors to the town, and hippos lazing around in the river. The Chobe River is the life support of thousands of animals, as well as the surrounding villages, especially during the dry winter months.



**Day 4****06 Aug 2014****Chobe National Park**

You will spend today on your remaining activities, with the option of organising other excursions through the lodge. Village visits, fishing excursions or extra boat cruises and game drives are available.

Day 5**07 Aug 2014****Chobe National Park ~ Okavango Delta**

This morning you will be taken to Kasane Airport in time to catch your light aircraft flight into the Okavango Delta. You will land at the Khwai Airstrip where you will be met by a guide and driven to **Banoka Bush Camp** to spend the next **3 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**.

Arrive: 07 Aug 2014 | Depart: 10 Aug 2014**3 nights (all meals and drinks)****Banoka Bush Camp**

Banoka Bush Camp is built along the tree line overlooking a lagoon in the Khwai Development Trust Community Concession adjoining the Moremi Game Reserve. Accommodation is in 10 en suite tented rooms complete with private verandas. There are 2 family tents which accommodate 2 adults and 2 children each. The main area consists of a bar, lounge, dining area and plunge pool and deck. There is an open campfire area to relax in and discuss the day's adventures. The whole camp is raised off the ground to take in the view. To minimise its impact on the ecology and still provide modern comforts, the camp is 100% solar powered.

Okavango Delta

The very word "Okavango" evokes a sense of adventure and exploration, and this is exactly what the Okavango Delta is about. Often called the Okavango Swamps, this intricate maze of waterways and sandy islands is an explorer's dream, and the destination should be on the wishlist of anyone looking for a unique travel experience. The geology of the Delta is fascinating, with its creation being attributed to tectonic plate action from thousands of years ago causing the Kavango River to flow from Angola into the Kalahari Desert as opposed to the Atlantic Ocean.

**Day 6 & 7****08 & 09 Aug 2014****Okavango Delta**

The Okavango Delta offers a range of experiences and you will have these 2 full days to enjoy the included walking safaris, mokoro excursions and day and night game drives.

Day 8**10 Aug 2014****Day of Departure**

This morning you will catch another light aircraft flight out of the Okavango Delta to Maun, where you will land in time to connect with your international flight **SA8301 (booked by you)** flying out of Botswana at **13h55**.
