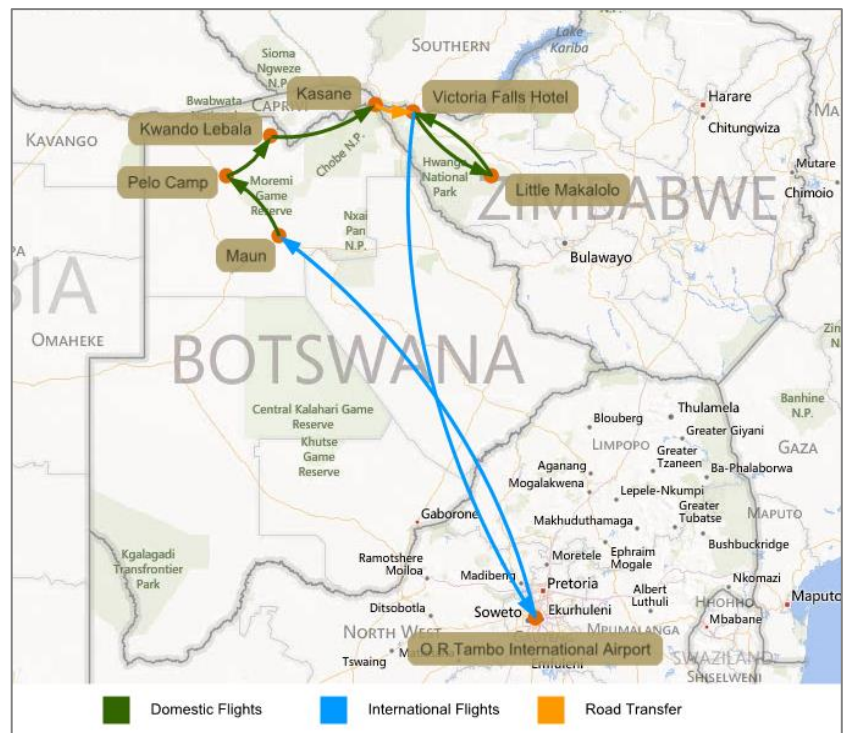

CANCELLATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- ▶ All cancellations must be advised of in writing
Cancellation penalties:
- ▶ For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
- ▶ For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
- ▶ For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)

INSURANCE

- ▶ African Ubuntu Safaris strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans

DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1	29 May 2014	Arrive in Okavango Delta

On arrival in Maun today (**flight on own arrangements**) you will be met after passing through immigration, and assisted onto your light aircraft flight to deep into the Okavango Delta, where you will spend your first **3 nights** at **Pelo Camp** on a **fully inclusive basis**.



Arrive: 29 May 2014 | Depart: 01 Jun 2014

3 nights (all meals and drinks)



Pelo Camp

Pelo Camp is situated on an island surrounded by permanent water in a true wetland area of the Okavango Delta. The word Pelo means 'heart' – a fitting name as, from the air, the island is heart-shaped. Accommodation is in 5 intimate guest tents each having a covered front veranda. The en suite bathroom has a flush toilet, running water in the basin and an outdoor bucket shower. A tented dining and lounge area is situated under impressive wild date palms, jackalberry and Natal mahogany trees.

Okavango Delta

The very word "Okavango" evokes a sense of adventure and exploration, and this is exactly what the Okavango Delta is about. Often called the Okavango Swamps, this intricate maze of waterways and sandy islands is an explorer's dream, and the destination should be on the wishlist of anyone looking for a unique travel experience. The geology of the Delta is fascinating, with its creation being attributed to tectonic plate action from thousands of years ago causing the Kavango River to flow from Angola into the Kalahari Desert as opposed to the Atlantic Ocean.



Day 2 & 3

30 & 31 May 2014

Okavango Delta

These 2 full days will be spent on the activities provided by Pelo Camp, including walking safaris, mokoro excursions and boat excursions through the channels of the Okavango.

Day 4

01 Jun 2014

Okavango Delta ~ Kwando, Linyanti and Selinda

From the wetlands of the Delta you will fly north today into the drier Linyanti region, where you will spend the next **3 nights** at **Lebala Camp** on a **fully inclusive basis**.

Arrive: 01 Jun 2014 | Depart: 04 Jun 2014

3 nights (all meals and drinks)



Kwando Lebala

Lebala is situated in the south of the Kwando concession, adjacent to the head waters of the Linyanti marshes that form the boundary between Botswana and Namibia. The camp comprises 8 custom designed tents, including family rooms, with unique mosquito net walls, allowing an unobstructed flow of cooling breezes and stunning views. Each spacious tent has its own viewing deck, bathroom and double outdoor showers. There are day and night off road game drives and seasonal game walks which are slow, comfortable strolls meant to provide you with a chance to experience the wilderness at a natural pace.



Kwando, Linyanti and Selinda

Just when you thought that lodges could not get any more remote or wild in Botswana! In the far north of the country, bordering Namibia, you will find the Selinda Spillway, the Linyanti River and Marsh, and the Kwando River. The Spillway is the waterway which connects the Okavango Delta with the Kwando and Linyanti Rivers, which then flow on to become the Chobe River. The wilderness areas supported by these waters have been divided into private concessions, on which are scattered very few, very luxurious, lodges. These are wonderful, out of the way locations, with unspoilt scenery, and excellent wildlife.



Day 5 & 6 **02 & 03 Jun 2014** **Kwando, Linyanti and Selinda**

The Linyanti is famous for its concentration of big game, and you will have 2 full days to explore the area on day and night game drives, and walking safaris operated by the camp.

Day 7 & 8 **04 & 05 Jun 2014** **Kwando, Linyanti and Selinda ~ Victoria Falls**

Flying out of the Linyanti today you will reach relative civilisation as you fly into Kasane, and transfer across the border into Zimbabwe, to the **Victoria Falls Hotel**, where you will spend the next **2 nights** on a **bed and breakfast basis**. This afternoon you will have time available to partake in activities of your choice, before heading out at **19h00** tonight for a fun- and music-filled dinner at the Boma Restaurant.

Arrive: 04 Jun 2014 | Depart: 06 Jun 2014 **2 nights (breakfast)**



Victoria Falls Hotel

The Edwardian-style 5 star hotel, built in 1904, redecorated and refurbished, now combines the charm of the old with the convenience of the new. The ambiance of the hotel is steeped in history with all suites decorated in the gracious Edwardian style of Zimbabwe's colonial era. It has 161 rooms comprising 37 standard rooms, 58 traditional rooms, 48 deluxe rooms, 7 junior suites, 4 honeymoon suites, 6 executive suites and the Royal Suite. The latter, as the name suggests, has seen reigning monarchs, presidents and, more recently, many famous Hollywood stars among its privileged occupants.

Victoria Falls

"Mosi Oa Tunya", or "The Smoke That Thunders", Victoria Falls are as magnificent on the 10th visit as they are on the 1st, and their thundering roar makes everything else seem strangely quiet once you leave them behind. As the mighty Zambezi flows over a chasm of 1 mile wide, and 110 metres high, to violently crash on the rocks below, the resultant spray is sent tens of metres up into the air, before it lands back down in a continuous rainfall.





Day 9

06 Jun 2014

Victoria Falls ~ Hwange National Park

This morning you will be able to arrange some more activities before collected from your hotel at **13h00** and taken to the Victoria Falls Airport in time for your flight at **14h00** to Hwange National Park, where you will be met on arrival at the airstrip and taken to **Little Makalolo Camp** to spend the next **3 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**.

Arrive: 06 Jun 2014 | Depart: 09 Jun 2014

3 nights (all meals and drinks)



Little Makalolo Camp

Little Makalolo Camp lies in the heart of Hwange National Park, in one of its best game viewing areas, overlooking a vibrant waterhole. The camp's 6 rooms have en suite facilities, with both indoor and outdoor showers. Solar power is used for electricity ensuring a lighter environmental footprint. The living areas include a dining room, lounge, plunge pool and an open fire for those convivial evening fireside tales. A log pile hide overlooks the waterhole in front of camp where you can enjoy wildlife viewing during the siesta hours. Activities at Little Makalolo Camp centre on open 4x4 Land Rover game drives and guided nature walks throughout the Makalolo concession.

Hwange National Park

Easily accessible from Victoria Falls, and bordering Botswana to the west, Hwange National Park has become famous for its wildlife density and enormous elephant population. Due to the arid region, the park is an incredible dry season safari destination, with animals converging on the many man-made water holes, and game viewing being especially rewarding. With over 100 species of mammals, and 400 species of birds, Hwange National Park is sure to provide you with some excellent photos and is a great inclusion on a Zimbabwe safari itinerary.



Day 10 & 11

07 & 08 Jun 2014

Hwange National Park

You 2 days here will be spent on day and night game drives exploring this beautiful park.

Day 12

09 Jun 2014

From Hwange you will fly back to Victoria Falls, where you will connect onto your flight **SA41** to Johannesburg departing at **13h15 (flight booked on your own arrangements)**.
