### CANCELLATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- ▶ All cancellations must be advised of in writing  
Cancellation penalties:
- ▶ For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
- ▶ For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
- ▶ For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)

### INSURANCE

- ▶ African Ubuntu Safaris strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans

## DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY

14 Jun 2014

Depart Perth

You will make your own way to Perth Airport today in time for your flight **SA281** departing at **23h50** for Johannesburg.



**Day 1****15 Jun 2014****Arrive in Chobe**

On arrival in Johannesburg at **05h45** this morning you will connect onto flight **SA8306** departing at **11h45** and landing in Kasane at **13h25** where you will be met after passing through immigration and transferred to the **Chobe Marina Lodge** to spend **1 night** on a **full board basis**. Two activities are included in your stay here, so depending on how you feel after your flights, you may go on a game drive or boat cruise this afternoon.

**Arrive: 15 Jun 2014 | Depart: 16 Jun 2014****1 night (all meals)**

### Chobe Marina Lodge

Located in Kasane, on the border of the Chobe National Park and on the banks of the Chobe River, Chobe Marina Lodge is surrounded by the natural beauty of Africa. Accommodation at Chobe Marina Lodge is provided in 60 rooms made up of studios, apartments, chalets, or suites with private lounges. All include the modern comforts of air-conditioning, television, telephones, mini bars and daily housekeeping. Dining experiences at the lodge include the a la carte Commissioners Restaurant, the more informal Mokoros Restaurant, and a pool bar and riverside bar overlooking the Chobe river.

### Chobe National Park

With an enormous elephant population, as well as magnificent birdlife and a huge array of herbivores and aquatic animals, it is often hard to believe that Chobe National Park is for real. The game viewing starts from the moment you land at Kasane Airport, with warthogs foraging in the streets, buffalo being habitual visitors to the town, and hippos lazing around in the river. The Chobe River is the life support of thousands of animals, as well as the surrounding villages, especially during the dry winter months.

**Day 2 & 3****16 & 17 Jun 2014****Chobe National Park**

You may be able to fit in an activity this morning before you move to the **Chobe Safari Lodge** a short walk away, where you will spend **2 nights** on a **full board basis**. Two game drives and two boat cruises are included in your stay here, which you will try and fit into these two days.

**Arrive: 16 Jun 2014 | Depart: 18 Jun 2014****2 nights (all meals)**

### Chobe Safari Lodge

Chobe Safari Lodge is situated on the banks of the Chobe River and shares a border with Chobe National Park. The Lodge's original accommodation types are traditional thatched rondavels. The newest additions to Chobe Safari Lodge are 46 safari rooms. Individually decorated, they afford you the luxury of air-conditioning, luxurious en suite bath and shower facilities, as well as satellite TV, and telephone.

**Day 4****18 Jun 2014****Chobe National Park ~ Victoria Falls**

This morning you will be collected from your lodge and transferred across the border into Zambia, where you will be taken to the banks of the Zambezi River. You will then travel by boat to **Sindabezi Island** to spend the next **2 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**.

**Arrive: 18 Jun 2014 | Depart: 20 Jun 2014****2 nights (all meals and drinks)**

### Sindabezi Island

Sindabezi Island is an idyllic, exclusive camp on a very private isle on the Zambezi River, and is a sister lodge to Tongabezi. Sindabezi has only 5 open-sided thatched cottages, allowing you to soak up the sights and sounds of the African bush in a pristine setting. Views across the flood plains of the Zambezi and into the nearby national park complete the experience. The entire Sindabezi Island is lit with traditional hurricane lamps and candles, and all the chalets on the island have solar heated water. Some of the many inclusive activities available to you are: game drives, bush walks, canoeing on the Zambezi, island lunch, sanpan floating candlelit dinner, visit to Mukuni Park, sunrise and sunset boating, introduction to Simonga Village, visit to Victoria Falls, museum tour, fishing, and a visit to Maramba Market.

### Victoria Falls

"Mosi Oa Tunya", or "The Smoke That Thunders", Victoria Falls are as magnificent on the 10th visit as they are on the 1st, and their thundering roar makes everything else seem strangely quiet once you leave them behind. As the mighty Zambezi flows over a chasm of 1 mile wide, and 110 metres high, to violently crash on the rocks below, the resultant spray is sent tens of metres up into the air, before it lands back down in a continuous rainfall. The water then rushes through an opening of only 50 metres, as the Zambezi races further along, over churning rapids and through the deep Batoka Gorge. While the Falls are the major drawcard, there is a thriving tourist industry developed around them, with adventure activities of all forms being available.

**Day 5****19 Jun 2014****Victoria Falls**

Today will be filled with enjoying activities of your choice of the many that are available at the camp and in the area. You will no doubt visit the Falls themselves and enjoy the spectacular views of the natural wonder from the Zambian side. *Entrance fee of US\$20 is payable directly at the Falls.*

**Day 6****20 Jun 2014****Victoria Falls ~ Kruger National Park**

This morning you will have time for one more activity before being transferred to Livingstone Airport for your flight **SA8871** to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport outside Nelspruit, departing at **13h45** and landing at **15h25**. You will be met after passing through immigration and driven into the Sabi Sands Game Reserve, where you will spend the next **4 nights at Dulini Lodge on a fully inclusive basis**. You will head out this afternoon for your first game drive experience, which will extend into the evening, before returning to the lodge for dinner.

**Arrive: 20 Jun 2014 | Depart: 24 Jun 2014****4 nights (all meals and drinks)****Dulini Lodge**

Located in the Sabi Sand Reserve, Dulini Lodge shares unfenced borders with the world renowned Kruger National Park. Set on the banks of the seasonal Mabrak River, this tranquil retreat beneath a leafy canopy of ebony trees offers you glimpses of the bush, with views of the nearby riverbed and the animal life centred round it. Nestled among the trees, 6 stone cottages, with classic interiors and private decks and plunge pools, face out toward the riverbed, with its green banks and suspension bridge. Daily game drives, in the early morning and late afternoon/evening, are in open 4x4 safari vehicles accompanied by an armed ranger and Shangaan tracker.

**Sabi Sands**

The Sabi Sand Reserve is part of the largest conservation area in South Africa and it is the oldest of all the private reserves. It was formed in 1950 and comprises of many privately owned game lodges, covering an area of 65 000 hectare/ 153 000 acre of savannah thornveld. It is now part of the Greater Kruger National Park and there are no fences between them, so the game moves freely through this enormous natural reserve. This is one of South Africa's most treasured natural sanctuaries.

**Day 7 - 9****21 - 23 Jun 2014****Kruger National Park**

These 3 full days will be spent enjoying game drives, guided nature walks, and relaxing in the African bush.

**Day 10****24 Jun 2014****Kruger National Park ~ Cape Town**

This morning you will be driven back to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport, where you will catch flight **SA8664** departing at **13h15** and landing in Cape Town at **15h55**, where you will be met and transferred to **The Commodore Hotel** to spend the next **3 nights on a bed and breakfast basis**.

**Arrive: 24 Jun 2014 | Depart: 27 Jun 2014****3 nights (breakfast)****The Commodore Hotel**

Overlooking the V&A Waterfront with views of Table Mountain, Robben Island, the harbour and the Atlantic Ocean, the Commodore Hotel is a family-friendly Cape Town hotel connected to a shopping centre and close to Two Oceans Aquarium, Cape Quarter Lifestyle Village, and Metropolitan Golf Club. The 236 en suite air conditioned guestrooms are bright and spacious, and decorated in a nautical style.

**Cape Town**

Cape Town has regularly been voted amongst the world's most popular holiday destinations, with many visitors returning year after year. Scenically spectacular, with an array of activities on offer, and easily accessible by plane, train, or boat, Cape Town is a great holiday destination on its own or added on to other safaris. Cape Town offers an enjoyable way to ease into, or wind down, an African itinerary.

**Day 11 & 12****25 - 26 Jun 2014****Cape Town**

You will have 2 full days to enjoy the beautiful city of Cape Town. On **25 June** you will be collected at **09h00** for a full day Cape Point and Stellenbosch Cape Winelands tour, allowing you to learn some more about the city, and to see the stunning coastline as well as the scenic inland mountains and valleys.

**Day 13****27 Jun 2014****Day of Departure**

You will have almost a full day in Cape Town before being transferred back to Cape Town Airport in time for flight **SA366** departing at **18h50** and landing at **20h50**. In Johannesburg you will connect onto flight **SA280** departing at **22h20** for Perth.

**Day 14****28 Jun 2014****Arrive in Perth**

You will arrive in Perth today at **13h25** to return home full of incredible memories of Africa.
