**Day 01: 02 Nov 2013**

**Arrival into Cape Town**

**Jess & Alex only:** On arrival at Cape Town International Airport this morning at **11h40** on flight **EK772** you will be met and transferred to the **Camps Bay Resort** where you will spend the next **3 nights** on a **room only basis**.

**Day 04: 05 Nov 2013**

**Cape Town – Johannesburg**

**Carol only:** On arrival at Johannesburg International Airport today (**flight details to be advised**) you will be met and transferred to the **Garden Court Sandton City**, to spend **4 nights** on a **bed and breakfast basis**.

### Garden Court Sandton City

The Garden Court Sandton City offers spacious rooms and facilities where you can relax in comfort. The hotel is within close proximity to South Africa's largest business hub, Sandton, and is adjacent to the Sandton Convention Centre, Sandton City and Nelson Mandela Square shopping centres.

**Day 02 - 04: 06 – 08 Nov 2013**

This morning you will be transferred to O R Tambo Airport in time for flight **SA1225** to Hoedspruit, departing at **10h15** and landing at **11h20**, from where you will be met and transferred to **Simbavati River Lodge** where you will spend **3 nights** on a **full board basis** in the **family suite**.

### **Simbavati River Lodge**

Built on the banks of the Nhlalarumi River, Simbavati River Lodge is an intimate and friendly camp built located in the heart of the world famous Timbavati Private Nature Reserve, bordering the Kruger National Park.

Set in the shade of old Jackalberry and Leadwood trees, Simbavati is warm and welcoming, and hosts guests in luxury tented rooms or thatched chalets.



**Day 06 & 07: 10 & 11 Nov 2013**

### **Timbavati (Kruger National Park)**

You will be met at Cape Town Airport and transferred to the **Waterfront Village Apartments** where you will spend **3 nights** in a luxury two-bedroom apartment on a **room only basis**.

### **Cancellation terms and conditions:**

- All cancellations must be advised of in writing
- Cancellation penalties:
  - For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
  - For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
  - For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)

### **Insurance:**

- African Ubuntu Safaris strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans. African Ubuntu Safaris will not be liable for any costs resulting from any traveller's failure to purchase travel insurance.



### **Passenger and Travel Information**

- Travellers should bring only soft sided bags on safaris.
- All travellers must have Identification Card / Passport with them for internal flights.
- Luggage restrictions are in place when travelling in Africa, especially concerning light aircraft flights. In general, in Southern Africa the weight limit is 20 kgs per person, and in East Africa the limit is 15 kgs per person. This includes hand luggage. It is possible to pay for extra weight allowance.
- A yellow fever vaccination is compulsory for a number of African countries. Please consult a travel doctor for up to date information.
- Travellers must have a passport which is valid for more than 6 months after the end date of the itinerary.
- Travellers' passports must have a minimum 2 blank pages per country to be visited
