## Detailed Itinerary

### Day 01: 15 Dec 2012                      Cape Town - Okavango Delta                      D

This morning you will make your way to Cape Town Airport in time for flight **SA314** departing at **08h00** and landing in Johannesburg at **10h00**. In Joburg you will connect onto flight **SA8300** departing at **11h45** and landing in Maun at **13h15**.

On arrival in Maun you will be met and assisted onto your flight to **Moremi Crossing**, where you will spend the next **4 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**.

#### Moremi Crossing

Moremi Crossing is a new 16 tented camp built on a palm fringed island surrounded by the Moremi's game-rich seasonal floodplains and overlooking Chief's Island. Moremi Crossing will be a new style safari camp combining luxury with simplicity. This is a 100% eco-friendly development featuring the latest in solar and waste disposal technology.

Accommodation consists of 16 en suite and spacious tents on raised decks, each with their own veranda.



### Day 02 - 04: 16 - 18 Dec 2012                      Okavango Delta                      B/L/D

These 3 full days will be spent on activities on offer from Moremi Crossing, including walking safaris, mokoro excursions, boat trip and fishing excursions.



#### Okavango Delta

The very word "Okavango" evokes a sense of adventure and exploration, and this is exactly what the Okavango Delta is about. Often called the Okavango Swamps, this intricate maze of waterways and sandy islands is an explorer's dream, and the destination should be on the wishlist of anyone looking for a unique travel experience.

The geology of the Delta is fascinating, with its creation being attributed to tectonic plate action from thousands of years ago causing the Kavango River to flow from Angola into the Kalahari Desert as opposed to the Atlantic Ocean.

### Day 05: 19 Dec 2012                      Okavango Delta                      B/L/D

Today you will catch a flight to **Pom Pom Camp** where you will spend the next **2 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**.

#### Pom Pom Camp

The Camp is located on Pom Pom Island in a private concession situated in the heart of the Okavango Delta and on the head waters of the Xudum river system. The area lies on the western boundary of the Moremi Game Reserve and offers superb Okavango scenery and a true Okavango wilderness experience.

The main building is attractively designed and constructed of thatch and canvas and comprises lounge, dining, bar and pool areas, as well as a gift shop and the boma area.

The swimming pool is situated close to the main lodge and the bar, making a perfect location for you to enjoy a relaxing afternoon in the heat of the day. Accommodation consists of 9 luxury safari tents in true traditional safari style, all with full en suite semi open ablution facilities.





**Day 06: 20 Dec 2012**

**Okavango Delta**

**B/L/D**

Pom Pom Camp offers a range of experiences and you will have the full day to enjoy the included walking safaris, mokoro and boat excursions, fishing trips, and day and night game drives.

**Day 07: 21 Dec 2012**

**Victoria Falls**

**B**

This morning you will catch a flight out of the Okavango Delta to Kasane, where you will be met on arrival and transferred across the border into Zimbabwe, and onwards to Victoria Falls.

You will be dropped off at **The Kingdom Hotel** where you will spend the next **2 nights** on a **bed and breakfast basis**. This afternoon you will be collected from your hotel and taken on a guided tour of the Falls.

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**Day 08: 22 Dec 2012**

**Victoria Falls**

**B**

This morning at **06h15** you will be collected from your hotel and taken for your morning **elephant back safari**. At **11h15** you will be taken to fly above the Falls on the "**Flight of Angels**" **13 minute helicopter flip**, allowing you remarkable views of the Zambezi gorge and the surrounding countries. At **16h15** this afternoon, you will be taken onto the mighty Zambezi River on a **sunset cruise**.

<p><b><u>Victoria Falls</u></b></p> <p>"Mosi Oa Tunya", or "The Smoke That Thunders", Victoria Falls are as magnificent on the 10th visit as they are on the 1st, and their thundering roar makes everything else seem strangely quiet once you leave them behind.</p> <p>As the mighty Zambezi flows over a chasm of 1 mile wide, and 110 metres high, to violently crash on the rocks below, the resultant spray is sent tens of metres up into the air, before it lands back down in a continuous rainfall. The water then rushes through an opening of only 50 metres, as the Zambezi races further along, over churning rapids and through the deep Batoka Gorge.</p>	
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**Day 09: 23 Dec 2012**

**Day of departure**

**B**

You will have this morning free for another activity if you choose, or for some last minute shopping at the craft market, before being collected at **11h00** and transferred to Victoria Falls Airport in time for your flight **SA41** departing at **13h25** and arriving in Johannesburg at **15h10**.

In Johannesburg you will connect with your international departure flight back to Australia.

- **All cancellations must be advised of in writing**
- **Cancellation penalties:**
  - **For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)**
  - **For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply**
  - **For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)**

**Insurance:**

- **African Ubuntu Safaris strongly advises that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans.**

**Passenger Information**

- **Passengers should bring only soft sided bags on safaris.**
- **All the passengers must have Identification Card/Passport with them for internal flights.**
- **Baggage on internal flights is strictly limited to 20kgs per person (including hand luggage) in soft sided bags. Any excess baggage will be charged by the airline at check-in.**
