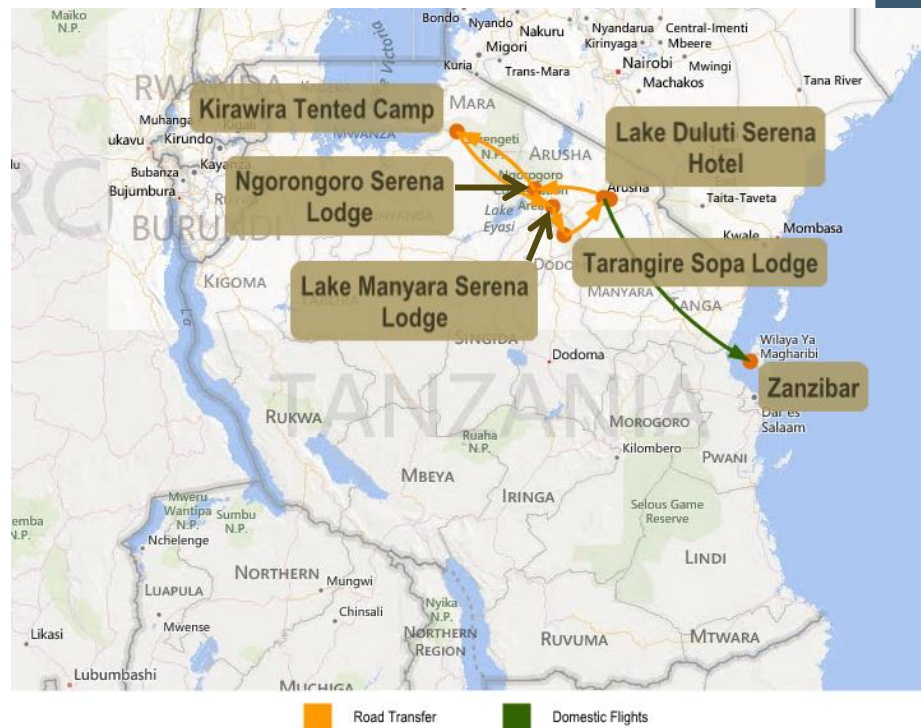

DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1**31 Oct 2014****Arrive in Arusha**

On arrival at **Kilimanjaro International Airport** off your **International Flight QR134** at **10h10** you will be met and transferred to the **Lake Duluti Serena Hotel** where you will spend **03 Nights** on a **Bed & Breakfast** Basis. Welcome to Africa!

Arrive: 31 Oct 2014 | Depart: 03 Nov 2014**3 nights (breakfast)**

Lake Duluti Serena Hotel

Nestled at the foot of the wooded slopes of Mount Meru, the Lake Duluti Serena Hotel is situated amid coffee plantations on the shores of tranquil Lake Duluti. Designed to echo the traditional style of the colonial coffee farm, which originally existed on this site, the hotel offers a range of cottage-styled rooms set amid extensive flower gardens and lawns, featuring a stone built reception with adjoining lounge, library, elegant dining room, boutique, gift shop, and business centre with WiFi.

Day 2 & 3**01 & 02 Nov 2014****Arusha**

You will have these two days at your leisure on your own arrangements.

Day 4**03 Nov 2014****Arusha ~ Ngorongoro Crater**

Morning at leisure with safari briefing followed by lunch. Afternoon join a shared vehicle safari and you depart Arusha, passing through the Masai Steppe. At the town of Makuyuni you turn North West and continue the journey up through a scenic escarpment and through the town of Karatu where you reach the Ngorongoro Park Gate and continue to the **Ngorongoro Serena Lodge** perched on the crater rim. Spend **02 Nights** at the **Ngorongoro Serena Lodge** on a **Full Board** Basis.

Arrive: 03 Nov 2014 | Depart: 05 Nov 2014**2 nights (all meals)**

Ngorongoro Serena Lodge

The Ngorongoro Serena Lodge clings to the rim of the magnificent Ngorongoro Crater. The lodge is built from local river stone and camouflaged with indigenous vines. Linked by arched stone passages and timbered decks, the lodge and rooms are decorated with stylized prehistoric cave paintings. Each with its own rock enclosed balcony, the 75 rooms feature brass lamps, embossed leather headboards, wildwood mirrors, and Masai carvings.



Ngorongoro Crater

A unique and fascinating game viewing destination, the Ngorongoro Crater is a must-see on any Tanzania safari. Being the world's largest intact caldera, and the result of a collapsed volcano thousands of years ago, the 260 square kilometres of crater floor hosts up to 25 000 animals at all times of year. This makes it one of the most dense wildlife areas in Africa, and allows for many memorable sightings.

**Day 5****04 Nov 2014****Ngorongoro Crater**

A highlight awaits you this morning as you descend with a picnic lunch through the early morning mists and 2,000 feet into the crater. Due to its size and diversity, the crater floor is comprised of several distinct areas, ranging from forest, swamps, lakes and springs, to open grassland and some sandy dunes. It's an awesome wildlife experience. A picnic lunch is served overlooking a small lake populated with hippos. You return to the **Ngorongoro Serena Lodge** in the late afternoon.

Day 6**05 Nov 2014****Ngorongoro Crater ~ Serengeti National Park**

Morning depart Ngorongoro and continue on the highway to Serengeti arriving at Naabi Hill Gate. Once cleared for entrance into Serengeti National Park, you game drive en route to the **Kirawira Tented Camp** where you will arrive in time for lunch. Afternoon is spent exploring the park and its inhabitants, returning to the **Kirawira Tented Camp** in the early evening. Spend **02 Nights** at the **Kirawira Tented Camp** on a **Full Board** Basis.

Arrive: 05 Nov 2014 | Depart: 07 Nov 2014**2 nights (all meals)**

Kirawira Tented Camp

Kirawira Camp in the western Serengeti has 25 widely spaced luxury tents, raised on timber platforms, with glorious views of the plains. Each tent has a spacious deck leading to a bedroom furnished in antique Edwardian style with steamer-trunks, writing desk, brass lamps, rugs, sepia photographs and four-poster bed with patchwork quilt. The luxurious en suite bathroom is fitted with carved mahogany furniture and features a classic black and white tiled floor.

Serengeti National Park

The word "Siringit" means "endless plains", and this is understandably from where the Serengeti National Park takes its name. The iconic, endless, golden plains of Africa are nowhere more evident than within this national park, as they stretch off into eternity, dotted throughout with thousands of animals. Located in the north-west corner of Tanzania, alongside Lake Victoria, the Serengeti has earned its place as one of the world's most famous wildlife areas.





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| Day 7 | 06 Nov 2014 | Serengeti National Park |
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Today will be spent on morning and afternoon game drives across the Serengeti plains in search of the remarkable game concentrations with the attendant predators and scavengers.

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| Day 8 | 07 Nov 2014 | Serengeti National Park ~ Lake Manyara National Park |
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Morning depart Serengeti National Park and drive past Ngorongoro Crater. On exiting the Ngorongoro Conservation Area you pass through the town of Karatu and arriving at the **Lake Manyara Serena Lodge** perched on the edge of the Great African Rift Valley overlooking Lake Manyara National Park below. Lunch is provided followed by an afternoon game drive in Lake Manyara National Park. Return to the **Lake Manyara Serena Lodge** in the early evening for dinner. Spend **01 Night** at the **Lake Manyara Serena Lodge** on a **Full Board** Basis.

Arrive: 07 Nov 2014 | Depart: 08 Nov 2014

1 night (all meals)



Lake Manyara Serena Lodge

Lake Manyara Serena Lodge stands on the edge of an escarpment with panoramic views over Lake Manyara. Beyond the timbered reception are the central dining room, bar and veranda, grouped around a "vanishing horizon" pool below. Dotted around the grounds, all with views over the lake, are white-washed 2 storey thatched 'rondavels', which house the spacious circular en suite rooms, each with its own small veranda.

Lake Manyara National Park

Being a relatively small park, and with Lake Manyara taking up the majority of the area, Lake Manyara National Park can be covered easily on half-day game drives, but these drives are usually very rewarding despite their brevity. The scenery and birdlife are Lake Manyara's major attractions, with the lake being perfectly located to offer spectacular views along the Great Rift Valley.



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| Day 9 | 08 Nov 2014 | Lake Manyara National Park ~ Tarangire National Park |
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Departing Lake Manyara after breakfast and head south east past Mto wa Mbu village and continue to Tarangire National Park.. Once you enter Tarangire National Park you game drive to the **Tarangire Sopa Lodge** and arrive in time for lunch. After lunch and perhaps a swim, the remainder of the afternoon will be spent on a game drive. Spend **01 Night** at the **Tarangire Sopa Lodge** on a **Full Board** Basis.

Arrive: 08 Nov 2014 | Depart: 09 Nov 2014

1 night (all meals)



Tarangire Sopa Lodge

Tarangire Sopa Lodge provides 75 spacious rooms furnished with a mini bar and 2 queen size beds including mosquito nets. The Lodge lies hidden among the kopjes and surrounded by ancient baobab trees. Tarangire is home to a concentration of elephants, and showcases other game including the elusive leopard. Over 400 bird species can be spotted here as well.



Tarangire National Park

One of the best dry season parks in the region, from July through to October an enormous amount of wildlife is drawn inside Tarangire to access the water from the Tarangire River and the Silale Swamps, allowing for very rewarding game viewing experiences. The park is home to some of the largest elephant herds of East Africa, and the scenery is particularly popular for the wide open, Serengeti-like plains, decorated with enormous and commanding Baobab trees.

**Day 10****09 Nov 2014****Day of Departure**

This morning you will leave Tarangire behind and drive back to Arusha where you will have lunch. After lunch you will be transferred to the Arusha Airport for your **Scheduled ZanAir Flight** to Zanzibar departing at **14h:30**. On arrival at the **Zanzibar International Airport** at **16h00**, you will make your own way.
