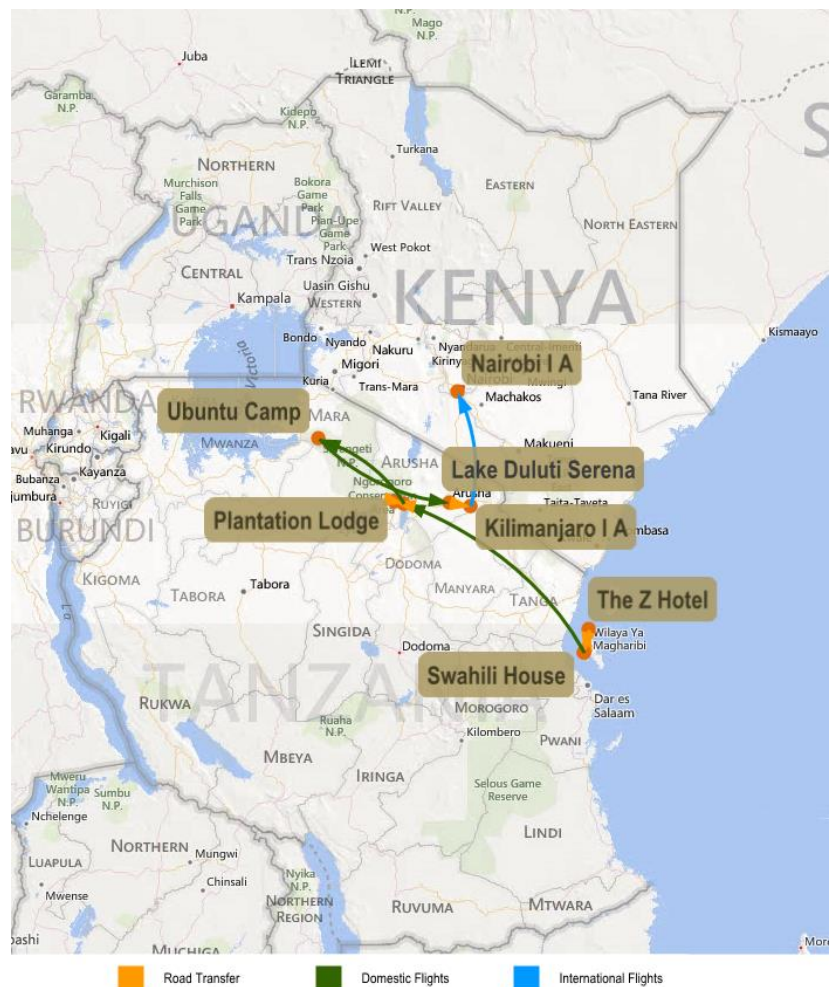

CANCELLATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- ▶ All cancellations must be advised of in writing
Cancellation penalties:
- ▶ For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)

INSURANCE

- ▶ African Ubuntu Safaris strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans
- ▶ African Ubuntu Safaris will not be liable for any costs resulting from any traveller's failure to purchase sufficient travel insurance

LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS ON LIGHT AIRCRAFT

Many itineraries include light aircraft flights. Please note that these flights have very strict luggage restrictions. Please take note of the following:

East Africa:

- ▶ Bags must be **completely soft sided**. At present, bags with frames and wheels are accepted, provided the rest of the bag is soft.
- ▶ The weight limit is **15 kg per person**. This **includes hand luggage**.
- ▶ Extra weight allowance can be purchased in advance.

If your bags do not fit the requirements, you may be asked to purchase a suitable bag from the airline and repack your belongings into this.

DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1**25 Oct 2014****Arrive in Stone Town**

Upon arrival at the **Zanzibar International Airport** off your **Flight KQ 498 (flight on own arrangement)** at **23h55**, you will be met and transferred to the **Swahili House** where you will spend **01 Night** in a **Sultan Suite** on a **Bed & Breakfast** Basis.

Arrive: 25 Oct 2014 | Depart: 26 Oct 2014**1 night (breakfast)**

Swahili House

Swahili House, located in the heart of Stone Town, was originally built in the 19th century. It has been restored to its original state, but with certain changes, combining traditional influences with modern day facilities. There are 5 floors which are built around a beautiful traditional Zanzibar courtyard. The 22 rooms spread out over 4 floors and are divided into 3 different room categories. All rooms are decorated in traditional Swahili style, but adjusted to Western standards with air conditioners and fans. Most of them have en suite bathrooms including a shower and bath.



Stone Town

The capital of Zanzibar is Zanzibar Town, in which Stone Town is a bustling, energetic and fascinating ancient part. With narrow mazes as streets, and intricately carved doors decorating the white-washed buildings, Stone Town invites you to explore its inner zones, and many an hour can be spent taking it all in. The sights and sounds, and the spicy smells, somehow remind you of a time long ago, and on exiting the web of alleys you feel as if you have left behind another world in another age.

**Day 2****26 Oct 2014****Stone Town ~ Zanzibar**

After breakfast at the **Swahili House**, you will be met at approximately **10h00** and transferred to the North Coast of the Island where you will spend **03 Nights** at the **Z- Hotel** in a **Rooftop Suite** on a **Half Board Basis**.

Arrive: 26 Oct 2014 | Depart: 29 Oct 2014**3 nights (dinner, breakfast)**

The Z Hotel

This chic, boutique hotel situated in a secluded plot on the corner of an idyllic beach in Nungwi, is located on the northern tip of Zanzibar. It blends elegant, contemporary design with traditional Zanzibari features to create a unique cool and relaxing environment. Set in a lush, tropical garden with direct access to the white powder beaches and warm waters of the Indian Ocean, the Z hotel has been finished to a high specification by an international team of architects and interior designers. There are 6 room designs, some having private decks over the sea.

Zanzibar

The Zanzibar Archipelago has lured travellers to its pristine, white beaches for centuries. The main island of Zanzibar (correctly named Unguja), has a plethora of accommodation options, ranging from rustic beach bungalows to large and glitzy resorts, and can offer something to everyone's taste. Sandy beaches run the length of the coast, shaded by green palm trees, and caressed by turquoise waters.

**Day 3 & 4****27 & 28 Oct 2014****Zanzibar**

These two full days will be spent at leisure, enjoying some of the numerous activities available on the Island or just relaxing on the beach or at the pool with a cocktail.

**Day 5****29 Oct 2014****Zanzibar ~ Ngorongoro Crater**

On this last day of your Zanzibar Stay you will check out of the **Z- Hotel** and be met at approximately **07h15** for transfer to the **Zanzibar International Airport** for your **Coastal Aviation Flight** departing at **09h30** to Lake Manyara. Upon arrival at the **Manyara Airstrip** at **13h25**, you will be met by your experienced Naturalist Driver-Guide in a Private 4WD Vehicle and undertake a Game Drive in the Lake Manyara National Park. Early in the evening you will proceed to the **Plantation Lodge** in the Ngorongoro Highlands where you will spend **02 Nights** on a **Full Board** Basis.

Arrive: 29 Oct 2014 | Depart: 31 Oct 2014**2 nights (all meals)****Plantation Lodge**

Plantation Lodge is located not far from the entrance to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and the Tarangire and Lake Manyara National Parks, and just a short journey from the Serengeti. The 16 individually furnished rooms and suites are distributed throughout the garden, some with verandas and direct access to the garden. A variety of flowering and fragrant trees and shrubs, such as bougainvillea, frangipani and jacaranda fill the garden which is put to good practical use, providing fruits from the mango and avocado trees for the guests. Coffee trees are also grown there. Colourful birds such as Fischer's lovebirds or the yellow-bellied sunbird are regular visitors to the Lodge.

Ngorongoro Crater

A unique and fascinating game viewing destination, the Ngorongoro Crater is a must-see on any Tanzania safari. Being the world's largest intact caldera, and the result of a collapsed volcano thousands of years ago, the 260 square kilometres of crater floor hosts up to 25 000 animals at all times of year. This makes it one of the most dense wildlife areas in Africa, and allows for many memorable sightings.

**Day 6****30 Oct 2014****Ngorongoro Crater**

A highlight awaits you this morning as after breakfast you descend with a picnic lunch through the early morning's mist and 2,000 feet into the crater. Due to its size and diversity, the crater floor is comprised of several distinct areas, ranging from forest, swamps, lakes and springs, to open grassland and some sandy dunes. It's an awesome wildlife experience. A picnic lunch is served overlooking a small lake populated with hippos. You return to the **Plantation Lodge** in the late afternoon.

Day 7**31 Oct 2014****Ngorongoro Crater ~ Serengeti National Park**

After an early Breakfast you will be transferred to the **Manyara Airstrip** your **Coastal Aviation Flight** departing at **07h55** to Northern Serengeti's Kogatende Airstrip. Upon arrival at the Kogatende Airstrip at **10h05** you will be met by an **Ubuntu Mobile Tented Camp** Representative and transferred (with game-viewing en-route) to the **Ubuntu Mobile Tented Camp**. Spend **03 Nights** at the **Ubuntu Mobile Tented Camp** in close proximity to the Mara River on a **Fully Inclusive** Basis.



Arrive: 31 Oct 2014 | Depart: 03 Nov 2014

3 nights (all meals and drinks)



Ubuntu Camp

Ubuntu Camp is a mobile luxury tented camp which follows the natural flow of the wildebeest through the Serengeti eco-system. From August to November the camp is perfectly positioned in a new campsite to intercept the animals as they arrive in the north. Each tent is either a double or twin (triples available), with flush toilets and running water in en-suite bathrooms. Hospitality, great food, and a wonderful relaxed environment is the essence of Ubuntu Camp.

Serengeti National Park

The word "Siringit" means "endless plains", and this is understandably from where the Serengeti National Park takes its name. The iconic, endless, golden plains of Africa are nowhere more evident than within this national park, as they stretch off into eternity, dotted throughout with thousands of animals. Located in the north-west corner of Tanzania, alongside Lake Victoria, the Serengeti has earned its place as one of the world's most famous wildlife areas.



Day 8 & 9

01 & 02 Nov 2014

Serengeti National Park

These two days will be spent on morning and afternoon (or full day with packed lunch) game drives in an open-sided 4WD Vehicle across the Serengeti, in search of the remarkable game concentrations with the attendant predators and scavengers.

Day 10

03 Nov 2014

Day of Departure

After a morning game drive en route to the Kogatende Airstrip, you will board your **Coastal Aviation Safari Flight** departing at **09h45** for Arusha. On arrival at the **Arusha Airport** at **11h45**, you will be met and transferred to the **Duluti Serena Hotel** for lunch. You will also have a Day Room at your disposal. Late afternoon you will be met at the **Duluti Serena Hotel** and transferred to the Kilimanjaro International Airport for your **Flight KQ6725** departing at **19h30** to Nairobi. Upon arrival at Nairobi's **Jomo Kenyatta International Airport** at **20h30**, you will connect with your **International Flight BA0064 (flight on own arrangement)** departing at **23h50** to London.
