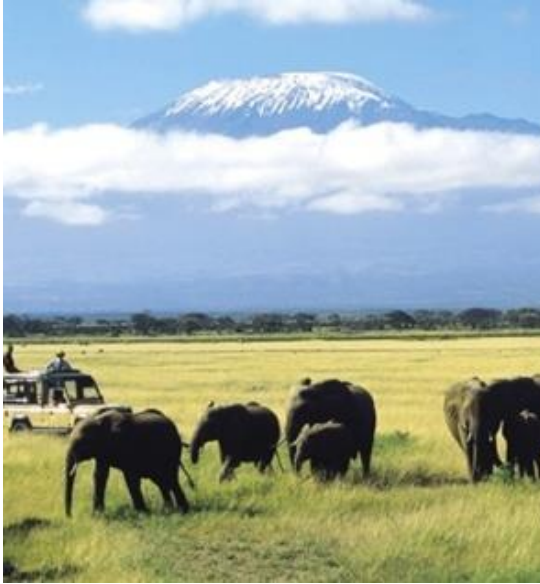

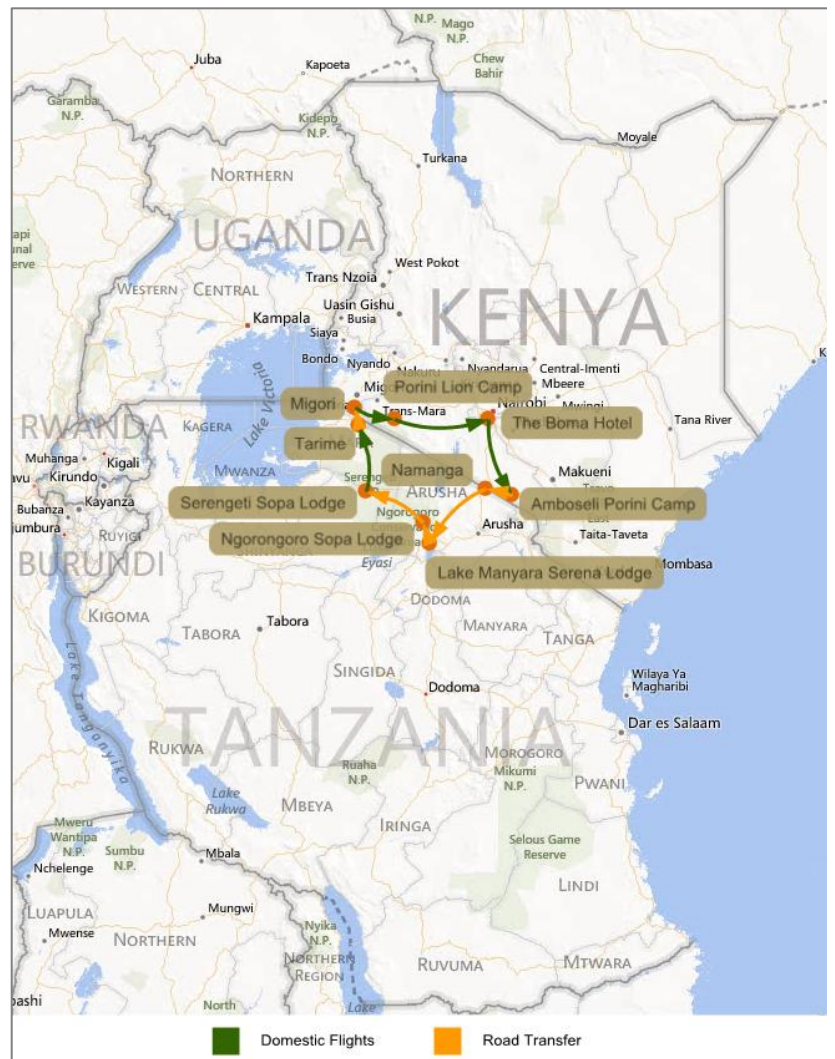

CANCELLATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- ▶ All cancellations must be advised of in writing
Cancellation penalties:
- ▶ For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
- ▶ For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
- ▶ For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)

INSURANCE

- ▶ African Ubuntu Safaris strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans
- ▶ African Ubuntu Safaris will not be liable for any costs resulting from any traveller's failure to purchase sufficient travel insurance



LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS ON LIGHT AIRCRAFT

Many itineraries include light aircraft flights. Please note that these flights have very strict luggage restrictions. Please take note of the following:

East Africa:

- ▶ Bags must be **completely soft sided**. At present, bags with frames and wheels are accepted, provided the rest of the bag is soft.
- ▶ The weight limit is **15 kg per person**. This **includes hand luggage**.
- ▶ Extra weight allowance can be purchased in advance.

If your bags do not fit the requirements, you may be asked to purchase a suitable bag from the airline and repack your belongings into this.

DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY

31 Jul 2014

Depart Brisbane

You will make your way to Brisbane Airport in time to board flight **Jet Airways India (9W)4051** leaving for Singapore at **10h00** and landing there at **16h10**. You then connect on to flight **Jet Airways India (9W)11** leaving for Mumbai at **20h05** landing at **23h10**. After a few hours you will then board flight **Jet Airways India (9W)6203** flying to Nairobi at **03h20**.

Day 1

01 Aug 2014

Arrive in Nairobi

On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi at **06h45** you will be met after passing through immigrations and transferred to **The Boma Hotel** where you will spend **1 night** on a **bed and breakfast basis**. Jambo! Karibu to Kenya! (Hello! Welcome to Kenya!)

Arrive: 01 Aug 2014 | Depart: 02 Aug 2014

The Boma Hotel

The Boma Hotel consists of 148 luxury guest rooms, in a variety of different categories. An executive lounge is available for guests staying in deluxe rooms and suites. All rooms and suites come with luxury amenities including complimentary high-speed Internet access, multimedia plug and play port, LED television, direct dial up telephone, and have access to 24 hour room service. Also provided are hairdryers, mini bars, tea and coffee making facilities, mineral water, weighing scales, in room safes, black out curtains, double glazed windows, and laundry kits.

Nairobi

Kenya's capital city has risen from a highland swampland called by the Ewaso Nai'beri – the place of cold – by the local Masai. When railway workers reached this area in 1899, they set up a basic camp and supply depot. The camp became a rustic village, and then a shanty town, which by 1907 was the capital of all of British East Africa. It was soon an important centre for the colony and a mecca for adventurers, hunters and travellers from all over the world. Modern Nairobi is still the safari capital of the Africa, and has become one of Africa's largest and most interesting cities.



**Day 2****02 Aug 2014****Nairobi ~ Amboseli National Park**

This morning you will be collected early from your hotel and transferred to Wilson Airport in time for your flight to Amboseli. On arrival you will be met and driven to **Amboseli Porini Camp** where you will spend **2 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**

Arrive: 02 Aug 2014 | Depart: 04 Aug 2014**2 nights (all meals and drinks)****Amboseli Porini Camp**

Porini Amboseli Safari Camp is an award-winning safari camp set in the Amboseli eco-system within the exclusive Selenkay Conservancy- an important wildlife dispersal area for wildlife moving out of Amboseli National Park. The camp is small with just 9 spacious guest tents and retains all the charm and feel of the traditional luxury camps. Tents have solar powered electric lighting with en suite bathrooms including shower, wash basin and flush toilet. The camp provides an exclusive experience with a maximum of 18 guests at a time and is fully inclusive of meals and drinks.

Amboseli National Park

The combination of masses of animals, diverse eco-systems, and the splendid views of Mount Kilimanjaro make Amboseli National Park high up on the must-see list of any Kenyan safari. With desert landscapes to lush green swampland, the scenery changes entirely during game drives, with new photo opportunities presenting themselves all the time. Amboseli is famous for its huge elephant herds, and is home to a remarkable concentration of species and birdlife, all the while being watched over by the highest peak in Africa.

**Day 3****03 Aug 2014****Amboseli National Park**

Activities included at Amboseli Porini are day and night game drives, guided walking safaris and a visit to a Masaai village. These activities are shared with other camp guests. An exciting and active time will be spent here.

Day 4**04 Aug 2014****Amboseli National Park ~ Tanzania**

Leaving Kenya today you will be transferred from Amboseli to the Namanga Border Post where you will pass through immigrations and cross into Tanzania. Your Tanzanian guide will greet you at the border to drive you through Arusha for lunch, before continuing west towards Lake Manyara, to spend **1 night** at **Lake Manyara Serena Lodge** on a **full board basis**.

**Arrive: 04 Aug 2014 | Depart: 05 Aug 2014****1 night (all meals)**

Lake Manyara Serena Lodge

Lake Manyara Serena Safari Lodge stands high on the edge of a towering terracotta escarpment with panoramic views over Lake Manyara, and offers a blend of tranquillity, wildlife discovery, and ornithological richness. Grouped around a central 'vanishing horizon' pool, this Lodge features a simple timbered reception area, built in traditional African style, which is accessed via a bridge over a small stream. Beyond the reception are the central dining room, bar and veranda, below which lies the pool. Dotted around the grounds, all with views over the lake, are a series of circular, white-washed 2 storey thatched 'rondavels', which house the rooms. Each spacious circular room has its own small veranda.

Lake Manyara National Park

Being a relatively small park, and with Lake Manyara taking up the majority of the area, Lake Manyara National Park can be covered easily on half-day game drives, but these drives are usually very rewarding despite their brevity. The scenery and birdlife are Lake Manyara's major attractions, with the lake being perfectly located to offer spectacular views along the Great Rift Valley.

**Day 5****05 Aug 2014****Tanzania ~ Ngorongoro Crater**

After breakfast you will head into Lake Manyara National Park for a game drive. Leaving Lake Manyara behind in the afternoon, your guided journey continues into the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and to the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater where you will spend **2 nights** at the **Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge** on a **full board basis**.

Arrive: 05 Aug 2014 | Depart: 07 Aug 2014**2 nights (all meals)**

Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge

Situated on the eastern rim of the Ngorongoro Crater, a World Heritage Site, Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge has a magnificent view of the crater which is home to vast herds of buffalo, wildebeest, zebra and gazelles. The 90 double bedrooms of Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge each accommodates 2 queen sized beds and a separate dressing area. Every room has a glass fronted private veranda, where you can simply relax and relish the superb view of the Crater. There are also 6 single rooms with queen sized beds and glass sliding doors. Lodge facilities include a glass domed reception lobby on two levels with a coffee bar area, a circular high volume dining area, a bar with 4 fireplaces, an internet café, and a gift shop. All the major areas allow breathtaking views of the Crater through floor to ceiling windows.



Ngorongoro Crater

A unique and fascinating game viewing destination, the Ngorongoro Crater is a must-see on any Tanzania safari. Being the world's largest intact caldera, and the result of a collapsed volcano thousands of years ago, the 260 square kilometres of crater floor hosts up to 25 000 animals at all times of year. This makes it one of the most dense wildlife areas in Africa, and allows for many memorable sightings.

**Day 6****06 Aug 2014****Ngorongoro Crater**

A highlight awaits you this morning as you descend with a picnic lunch through the early morning mists and 2,000 feet down into Ngorongoro Crater, commonly referred to as the World's largest wildlife zoo. Due to its size and diversity, the crater floor is comprised of several distinct areas, ranging from forest, swamps, lakes and springs, to open grassland and some sandy dunes. It's an awesome wildlife experience. Lunch is enjoyed near a small lake filled with hippos. You then continue game viewing before returning to the crater's rim and your lodge.

Day 7**07 Aug 2014****Ngorongoro Crater ~ Serengeti National Park**

This morning you will drive to the south-central area of the Serengeti National Park, where you will spend the next **2 nights** at **Serengeti Sopa Lodge** on a **full board basis**.

Arrive: 07 Aug 2014 | Depart: 09 Aug 2014**2 nights (all meals)**

Serengeti Sopa Lodge

Serengeti Sopa Lodge is nestled in the acacia woodland on the edge of the escarpment overlooking the plains of the south-western Serengeti National Park. Accommodation is provided in 69 standard rooms, all with 2 queen size beds, carpeted, and furnished with local fabrics and pictures. On entering the room there is a lounge with a mini bar. A veranda with 2 comfortable chairs and coffee table faces the vast Serengeti plains. The rooms have en suite bathrooms and hairdryers. The interiors of the suites are painted with the same colours as the main building - terracotta, mustard and blue, which is incorporated in the fabrics.

Serengeti National Park

The word "Siringit" means "endless plains", and this is understandably from where the Serengeti National Park takes its name. The iconic, endless, golden plains of Africa are nowhere more evident than within this national park, as they stretch off into eternity, dotted throughout with thousands of animals. Located in the north-west corner of Tanzania, alongside Lake Victoria, the Serengeti has earned its place as one of the world's most famous wildlife areas.



**Day 8****08 Aug 2014****Serengeti National Park**

You will have the full day spent on game drives exploring the Serengeti Plains.

Day 9**09 Aug 2014****Serengeti National Park ~ Masai Mara Game Reserve**

After breakfast you will head to the Seronera Airstrip, where you will bid your guide farewell as you fly to the Tarime airstrip. You will then be transferred and assisted across the border to Migori airstrip, to continue your safari with a flight to the Masai Mara. You will be met on arrival at Ol Kiombo airstrip and driven to **Porini Lion Camp**, in the Olare Orak Conservancy, to spend the next **5 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**.

Arrive: 09 Aug 2014 | Depart: 14 Aug 2014**5 nights (all meals and drinks)****Porini Lion Camp**

This eco-friendly camp, in the 20,000 acre Olare Orok Conservancy which borders the Masai Mara Game Reserve, has no permanent structure and is situated along the Ntiakatiak River, a seasonal river with hippo pools nearby. There are 10 spacious tents all having an en suite bathroom with flush toilet and hot shower. A private veranda runs along the length of each tent, providing a secluded and private 'space' for you to relax and enjoy the beauty of this African wilderness. Day and night game drives in custom built open-sided 4x4's are accompanied by qualified safari guides. In the evenings you are served sundowners at a scenic spot while enjoying the beauty of an African sunset.

Masai Mara Game Reserve

It is no surprise that the Masai Mara ranks up near the top of most famous game reserves in the world. The land of the Mara is covered with herds of antelope, interspersed with prides of lions, journeys of giraffe, dazzles of zebra, and almost every other collective animal noun you can think of. The sightings are nothing short of fantastic, and it is definitely the park to visit to tick off your "wildlife of Africa" list. The scenery of the park is similar to the open plains of the Serengeti, although the Mara is dotted with more trees, and the game viewing is equal to, or can be better than, its southerly sister

**Day 10 - 13****10 - 13 Aug 2014****Masai Mara Game Reserve**

You will have 4 full days to enjoy the day and night game drives, walking safaris and Masai village visits, while also getting into the midst of the wildebeest migration. The activities here are shared with other camp guests.

Day 14**14 Aug 2014****Masai Mara Game Reserve ~ Nairobi**

This morning you fly from Masai Mara back to Wilson Airport in Nairobi, from where you will be transferred to the **Boma Hotel** to spend **1 night** on a **bed and breakfast basis**.

**Day 15****15 Aug 2014****Depart Nairobi**

You will be collected from your hotel today and transferred to Jomo Kenyatta International in time for your departure on flight **Jet Airways India (9W)6202** leaving at **17h35** for Mumbai, landing at **02h10**.

16 Aug 2014**Travel Day**

In Mumbai you connect with **Jet Airways India (9W)10** flying to Singapore at **9h50**. After landing at Singapore at **18h00** you will connect with flight **Jet Airways India (9W)4052** departing for Brisbane at **19h55** where you will land at **05h20** on Sunday August 17.
