Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: 14 August 2013 Arrival into Johannesburg

This morning you will make your own way to Sydney International Airport by 07h55 in order to check in to flight SA7701 departing at 09h55. On arrival at Johannesburg International Airport at 16h15 you will be met after passing through immigrations and transferred to the Peermont Mondior Hotel to spend 1 night on a bed and breakfast basis.

Peermont Mondior Hotel

The 4-star Peermont Mondior is an excellent hotel, offering great value for money, and the convenience of being situated right next to O.R. Tambo International Airport. Enjoy elegance at an attractive price. The hotel sets an exciting standard in world class business, conference and leisure accommodation. Day 02: 15 August 2013 Johannesburg B

You will have the morning free before being collected at 13h00 and taken on a 3 hour city tour of Johannesburg.

Johannesburg

Although usually only used for quick stopovers by most travellers, Joburg is an exciting and vibrant city, with some excellent hotels, fantastic shopping facilities, loads of historic significance, and a flourishing sporting culture. With the launch of the Gautrain in 2010, the Sandton district is now only 10 minutes from the airport, and this places one in a position to easily access most of the city's highlights. Visit Soweto, the Apartheid Museum, Constitutional Hill, the Lesedi Cultural Village, or spend time in the top class shopping centres, or playing some golf on the city's finest courses.

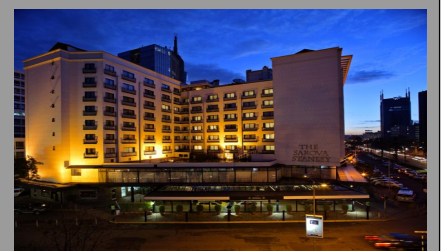


Day 03: 16 August 2013 Johannesburg - Nairobi B

This morning you will catch the free shuttle bus to the airport by 08h10 to check in for flight SA184 to Nairobi departing at 10h10 and landing at 15h10, where you will be met after passing through immigration and taken to the Sarova Stanley Hotel where you will spend 1 night on a bed and breakfast basis.

Sarova Stanley Hotel

Sarova Stanley, as Kenya's first luxury hotel, originating in 1902, is situated in the bosom of Nairobi, and therefore the history of the city and this hotel is inextricably linked. From the heat outside, you enter through the century old revolving doors into the cool Victorian elegance of the spacious foyer, with its patterned marble floors, chesterfields, old clocks and ancient photographs. There are 217 guest rooms over 8 floors in different categories including Heritage Suites, Executive Suites and Club Rooms. All guest rooms at Sarova Stanley offer a blend of Victorian elegance and comfort, combined with all the practical, executive amenities of the modern age.



Day 04: 17 August 2013 Nairobi - Amboseli National Park B/L/D

This morning you will be collected from your hotel and driven to Wilson Airport, where you will catch a flight departing at 07h30 to Amboseli National Park. You will be met upon landing at the airstrip and driven to Amboseli Porini Camp, to spend the next 3 nights on a fully inclusive basis.

The afternoon will be spent on a game viewing activity, before you enjoy your first dinner back in the African bush.

Porini Amboseli Camp

Porini Amboseli Safari Camp is an award winning safari camp set in the Amboseli eco-system within the exclusive Selenkay Conservancy - an important wildlife dispersal area for wildlife moving out of Amboseli National Park. The camp is small with just 9 spacious guest tents and retains all the charm and feel of the traditional luxury camps. Tents have solar powered electric lighting with en suite bathrooms including shower, wash basin and flush toilet. The camp provides an exclusive experience with a maximum of 18 guests at a time and is fully inclusive of meals and drinks.

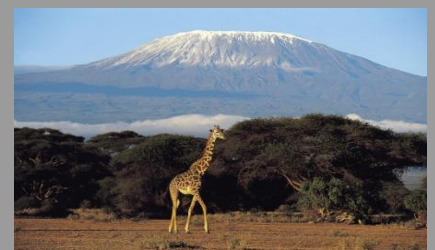


Day 05 & 06: 18 & 19 August 2013 Amboseli National Park B/L/D

These 2 days will be spent relaxing at the camp and enjoying the activities provided. Included during your stay are day and night game drives, walking safaris, sundowners and village visits. You can choose which activities you'd like to take part in.

Amboseli National Park

The combination of masses of animals, diverse eco-systems, and the splendid views of Mount Kilimanjaro make Amboseli National Park high up on the must-see list of any Kenyan safari. With desert landscapes to lush green swampland, the scenery changes entirely during game drives, with new photo opportunities presenting themselves all the time. Amboseli is famous for its huge elephant herds, and is home to a remarkable concentration of species and birdlife, all the while being watched over by the highest peak in Africa.



Day 07: 20 August 2013 Amboseli - Lake Elementaita B/L/D

This morning you will catch a flight back to Nairobi, departing at 09h05 and landing at 09h50 where you will be met by your private driver-guide, and depart for Nakuru and the lake region of Kenya. You will be driven to Sunbird Lodge where you will spend the next 3 nights on a full board basis.

Sunbird Lodge

Set on private land between Nakuru and Gilgil, and above Lake Elementaita, Sunbird Lodge is named after one of the more than 450 species of birds in this area. It offers 10 spacious en suite cottages built with natural materials and thatched roofs, each with a large private veranda from where you can enjoy spectacular sunsets and an unspoilt view over Lake Elementaita. Features include mosquito nets, safe and telephone. Dining is either in the restaurant, which also offers a marvellous view, or you can enjoy a pleasant outdoor experience under the stars (weather permitting) overlooking the swimming pool and Lake Elementaita/Soysambu. Two fire places will keep you warm during the cool evenings.



Day 08 & 09: 21 & 22 August 2013 Lakes region B/L/D

These 2 days will be spent enjoying the views from Sunbird Lodge, and exploring the surrounding region. On one of these days you will visit Lake Nakuru National Park and you will also have the option to visit Lake Bogoria if the guide decides it is worth seeing the flamingos there (depending on the number of birds in Nakuru).

Please note that park fees for Lake Bogoria will need to be paid for directly, and are not yet included in the price.

Lake Nakuru National Park

Accessed via a relatively short, but scenic drive from Nairobi, through the Great Rift Valley, Lake Nakuru National Park is a very popular destination, especially amongst birdlovers. To go with its beautiful scenery, Nakuru is the feeding ground for thousand upon thousand of flamingos which turn the entire landscape pink as they flock to the shallow lake. Although, in recent times, the movement of the flamingos has been unpredictable and at times very few are found in Nakuru, with them moving to surrounding lakes. Added to this, Lake Nakuru is one of the best locations in East Africa to view rhino's, and is home to both the black and white species.



Day 10: 23 August 2013 Lake Elementaita - Laikipia B/L/D

This morning you will drive back to Nairobi where you will be dropped off at Wilson Airport in time for your flight to Nanyuki, departing at 10h20. On arrival in Nanyuki you will be met and driven to Porini Rhino Camp, where you will spend the next 3 nights on a fully inclusive basis.

Porini Rhino Camp

Porini Rhino Camp is located in Ol Pejeta Conservancy, a 90,000 acre wildlife conservancy situated between the foot hills of the Aberdares and the magnificent snowcapped Mount Kenya. This conservancy boasts an astounding variety of animals including all the Big 5 (the endangered black rhino, leopard, elephant, buffalo and lion) as well a sanctuary for rescued chimpanzees. It also incorporates the smaller Sweetwaters Game Reserve. Porini Rhino Camp is hidden in a secluded valley and set amongst shady acacia trees on the banks of a seasonal river.

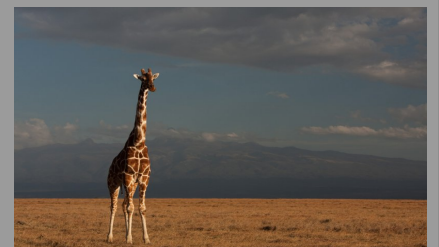


Day 11 & 12: 24 & 25 August 2013 Laikipia B/L/D

These 2 full days will be spent enjoying the activities offered at Porini Rhino Camp. These include day and night game drives, a visit to the Sweetwaters Chimpanzee Sanctuary and walking safaris.

Laikipia

It is always exciting when conservation efforts truly pay off, and the Laikipia Plateau is a place of much excitement! Originally extensive farmland, a huge effort has succeeded in reclaiming much of the land between the slopes of the Aberdares and the snowy peaks of the mighty Mount Kenya, and the area now boasts the second highest concentration of wildlife in Kenya. Second only to the Masai Mara! Divided up into private concessions, the Laikipia Plateau consists of accommodation in tented camps, as well as lavish bush homes, allowing for a wonderful personalised experience.



Day 13: 26 August 2013 Laikipia - Johannesburg B

This morning you will fly back to Nairobi Wilson Airport, departing at 10h20 and landing at 12h15, from where you will be transferred to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in time for your flight SA185 to Johannesburg, departing at 16h00 and landing at 19h15. On arrival in Johannesburg you will be met and transferred to the Da Vinci Hotel to spend 1 night on a bed and breakfast basis.

Davinci Hotel

Davinci Hotel And Suites On Nelson Mandela Square, Johannesburg, has direct access to Sandton Convention Centre, Sandton City, as well as the Michelangelo Towers Mall. Nearby points of interest also include Johannesburg Stock Exchange and Wanderers Stadium. The interior design focuses on a black and white theme throughout the public areas as well as hotel rooms and suites. 166 air-conditioned guestrooms at Davinci Hotel And Suites feature coffee/tea makers and complimentary bottled water. Accommodations offer city or courtyard views.



Day 14: 27 August 2013 Day of departure B

You will have most of the day free in Johannesburg today, where you will have time to peruse the Sandton shopping centres, before being transferred back to Johannesburg International Airport in time for your departure flight SA7700 departing at 18h15.

Cancellation terms and conditions:

- All cancellations must be advised of in writing
- Cancellation penalties:
 - For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
 - For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
 - For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)

Insurance:

- African Ubuntu Safaris strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans. African Ubuntu Safaris will not be liable for any costs resulting from any traveller's failure to purchase travel insurance.



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Passenger and Travel Information

- Travellers should bring only soft sided bags on safaris.
- All travellers must have Identification Card/Passport with them for internal flights.
- Luggage restrictions are in place when travelling in Africa, especially concerning light aircraft flights. In general, in Southern Africa the weight limit is 20 kgs per person, and in East Africa the limit is 15 kgs per person. This includes hand luggage. It is possible to pay for extra weight allowance.
- A yellow fever vaccination is compulsory for a number of African countries. Please consult a travel doctor for up to date information.
- Travellers must have a passport which is valid for more than 6 months after the end date of the itinerary.
- Travellers' passports must have a minimum 2 blank pages per country to be visited
