# **Detailed Itinerary**

Day 01: 14 Nov 2013 Depart Perth

Today you will make your way to Perth International Airport in time for your flight **SA 281** to Johannesburg departing Perth at **23h45**.

Day 02: 15 Nov 2013 Johannesburg ~ Linyanti D

In **Johannesburg** you will land at 05h15 at O R Tambo International Airport and make your way through the international transit area for your flight **SA 8300** to **Maun** departing at **11h45**, **arriving at 13h15**. At Maun you will be met after completing entrance formalities and assisted on to your flight to **Lagoon Camp** where you will spend **4 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**.



## Kwando Lagoon Camp

Lagoon is a camp perched on the banks of the wild Kwando River. It overlooks the Mudumu National Park which is in the Namibian Caprivi Strip. This camp is nestled beneath towering ebony and marula trees and accommodates up to 16 guests in 8 traditionally styled en suite tents with indoor/outdoor showers. The heavily forested site is home to a wide variety of birds and mammals, while elephant and hippo are normally visible from the camp. The stunning views and close proximity of wildlife all contribute to the pervading sense of calm at Lagoon.

Day 03 - 05: 16 - 18 Nov 2013

Lagoon Camp offers a wide range of experiences and you will have 3 full days to enjoy the walking safaris, mokoro and boat excursions, fishing trips, and the day and night game drives which are included in your stay.



## Linyanti

In the far north of the country, bordering Namibia, you will find the Selinda Spillway, the Linyanti River and Marsh, and the Kwando River. The Spillway is the waterway which connects the Okavango Delta with the Kwando and Linyanti Rivers, which then flow on to become the Chobe River. The wilderness areas supported by these waters have been divided into private concessions, on which are scattered very few, very luxurious, lodges.

## Little Kwara Camp

Little Kwara is located within the game rich Kwara concession, which borders the Moremi Game Reserve on the northern edge of the Okavango Delta. This is an intimate and exclusive camp, accommodating no more than 10 guests. There are 5 en suite tents, all with separate bath and outside showers. Little Kwara offers all the activities one expects in an exclusive concession in the Okavango Delta.

You will have these 2 full days to enjoy Little Kwara Camp and the surrounding wilderness, with off road day and night game drives and mokoro excursions exploring the area as well as power boating and fishing.



## Okavango Delta

The very word "Okavango" evokes a sense of adventure and exploration, and this is exactly what the Okavango Delta is about. Often called the Okavango Swamps, this intricate maze of waterways and sandy islands is an explorer's dream, and the destination should be on the wish list of anyone looking for a unique travel experience.

The geology of the Delta is fascinating, with its creation being attributed to tectonic plate action from thousands of years ago causing the Kavango River to flow from Angola into the Kalahari Desert as opposed to the Atlantic Ocean.

Day 09: 22 Nov 2013

You will fly out of the Delta to Kasane today, where you will be met and assisted on your road trip through the Zimbabwe border to **Victoria Falls**. You will spend **3 nights** at the **Victoria Falls Hotel** on a **bed and breakfast** basis.



#### Victoria Falls Hotel

The Victoria Falls Hotel, popularly known as "the grand old lady of the Falls", is situated in the Victoria Falls National Park, a world heritage site, and is a member of the exclusive Leading Hotels of the World group. The Edwardian-style five-star hotel, built in 1904, was recently redecorated and refurbished and now combines the charm of the old with the convenience of the new. Set in lush tropical gardens with lily ponds, palm trees and semi-tropical shrubs, it provides the tranquillity and seclusion that many guests seek.

Day 10 &11: 23 & 24 Nov 2013

Victoria Falls

You will have the 2 full days to enjoy some of the numerous activities available around the Falls. Chris and Samuel will be picked up at the hotel at **o6h4o** on the morning of **23 November** to have the thrilling experience of white water rafting on the mighty Zambezi River. At **16h0o** you will all be collected for a sunset cruise.

On **24 November** you will be collected at **10h00** from the hotel for a dramatic 13 minute helicopter flight over the Falls, and an entertaining African dinner experience complete with drums and dancing at the Boma Restaurant awaits you after being picked up at the hotel at **18h50**.

## Victoria Falls

"Mosi Oa Tunya", or "The Smoke That Thunders", Victoria Falls are as magnificent on the 10th visit as they are on the 1st, and their thundering roar makes everything else seem strangely quiet once you leave them behind. As the mighty Zambezi flows over a chasm of 1,6km wide, and 110 metres high, to violently crash on the rocks below, the resultant spray is sent tens of metres up into the air, before it lands back down in a continuous rainfall. The water then rushes through an opening of only 50 metres, as the Zambezi races further along, over churning rapids and through the deep Batoka Gorge.





Day 12: 25 Nov 2013

Victoria Falls~ Johannesburg

This morning you will be transferred to Victoria Falls Airport to fly back to Johannesburg on **SA041** departing at **13h25**. After landing at **15h10** you will be met after passing through immigration at O R International Airport and transferred to the Rosebank Holiday Inn to stay 1 night on a bed and breakfast basis. This evening you will be taken out for dinner by African Ubuntu Safari's Joburg office (restaurant to be decided).



## **Rosebank Holiday Inn**

Holiday Inn Johannesburg-Rosebank is located in a modern and relaxed extensive shopping precinct. Relax on the sunny pool deck when you arrive from O.R. Day 14 - 16: 27 Nov - 29 Nov 2013 Benguerra B/L/D

You will have the next 3 days to relax on the beautiful Indian Ocean beaches and to take part in the activities offered at the lodge including snorkelling and sailing and visits to the interior of the island.

## **Benguerra**

Benguerra is the second largest island in the Bazaruto Archipelago, approximately 55 sq km, and lies 14km offshore. It is famous for its unspoiled white beaches, remarkable dive sites and excellent fishing (subject to a strict "catch & release" policy). Inland, Benguerra Island comprises forest, savannah, freshwater lakes and wetland eco-systems that sustain a diverse population of fauna and flora. Fresh water crocodiles can be found in the three lakes, bearing testimony to the island's mainland past. The island, which is home to approximately 140 bird species, was declared a National Park in 1971.



Day 17: 30 Nov 2013 Bazaruto ~ Johannesburg ~ Perth

You will fly today from Benguerra to Vilanculos in time to catch flight SA 8241 departing at 13h30 for O R Tambo Airport in Johannesburg and landing at 15h45, in time to connect with your departure flight **SA 280** leaving for home at **21h25** after an amazing holiday. You will land back in Perth at 12h55 on 01 December 2013.

## **Passenger and Travel Information**

- Travellers should bring only soft sided bags on safaris.
- All travellers must have Identification Card / Passport with them for internal flights.
- Luggage restrictions are in place when travelling in Africa, especially concerning light aircraft flights. In general, in Southern Africa the weight limit is 20 kgs per person, and in East Africa the limit is 15 kgs per person. This includes hand luggage. It is possible to pay for extra weight allowance.
- A yellow fever vaccination is compulsory for a number of African countries. Please consult a travel doctor for up to date information.
- Travellers must have a passport which is valid for more than 6 months after the end date of the itinerary.
- Travellers' passports must have a minimum 2 blank pages per country to be visited
