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Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: 19 Feb 2013

Arrival into Johannesburg

On arrival in Johannesburg today at **15h35** on flight **SA7701** you will be met after passing through immigrations and transferred to the **Peermont Mondior**, 5 minutes from the airport, where you will spend **1 night** on a **bed and breakfast basis**.

When you make your way into the arrivals hall in Johannesburg, turn to your left, and make your way along the guard rail towards the information kiosk. You will be met there by Gerald McLaren, who will have an African Ubuntu Safaris signboard. If there are any hassles, contact Gerald on +27 83 334 8572.

Johannesburg

Although usually only used for quick stopovers by most travellers, Joburg is an exciting and vibrant city, with some excellent hotels, fantastic shopping facilities, loads of historic significance, and a flourishing sporting culture.

With the launch of the Gautrain in 2010, the Sandton district is now only 10 minutes from the airport, and this puts one in position to easily access most of the cities highlights.

Day 02: 20 Feb 2013

Johannesburg – Central Kalahari

This morning you will catch the free shuttle bus back to the airport in time for your flight **SA8300** to Maun, departing at **11h45** and landing at **13h25**. On arrival in Maun you will be assisted onto your light aircraft flight taking you into the Central Kalahari Game Reserve, where you will spend the next **3 nights** at **Kalahari Plains Camp** on a **fully inclusive basis**.



Kalahari Plains Camp

Kalahari Plains Camp is situated in a remote part of the diverse Central Kalahari Game Reserve, and offers you some excellent summer wildlife viewing opportunities. At 5 million hectares this reserve is the largest conservation area in the country and one of the largest in the world. It is home to the legendary Kalahari black-maned lion as well as offering some of the world's best cheetah viewing.

Kalahari Plains Camp is perfectly situated overlooking an immense pan with endless horizons and beautiful skies. It comprises 10 en suite canvas units with a sleep-out above each to enjoy moonlit or star-studded nights.

Day 03 & 04: 21 & 22 Feb 2013

Central Kalahari Game Reserve

B/L/D

These 2 full days will be spent on game viewing activities included at the camp, made up of game drives, walking safaris and bushman walks.



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Central Kalahari Game Reserve

Originally created to be a sanctuary for the San people inhabiting the Kalahari, the Central Kalahari is one of the largest, yet most remote, game reserves around.

Although growing in popularity now, the Central Kalahari is a park which is largely skipped by visitors to Botswana. This means you can experience the park in privacy, taking advantage of the excellent and unique wildlife sightings, without seeing many other people at all on the vast plains and ancient river beds which make up the landscape. Gemsbok (oryx) and springbok dominate the wildlife, while lions, honey badgers, cheetahs and zebra are also easily found.

Day 05: 23 Feb 2013

Central Kalahari – Okavango Delta

B/L/D

Today you will catch another light aircraft flight from the Central Kalahari to deep inside the Okavango Delta, where you will spend the next **3 nights** at **Vumbura Plains Camp** on a **fully inclusive basis**.



Vumbura Plains Camp

Vumbura Plains Camp is a luxury camp situated in a private concession in the extreme north of the Okavango Delta. The concession, which is leased from the neighbouring community, includes a wide variety of habitats in a traversing area of 60,000 hectares. The diverse wildlife has representatives of almost every animal type that occurs in the Okavango biome. Vumbura Plains Camp comprises 2 separate 7-suited satellite camps, each with its own raised dining, lounge and bar area tucked beneath a canopy of cool, shady, indigenous trees. A star-gazing deck with comfortable cushions protrudes into the floodplain.

Day 06 & 07: 24 & 25 Feb 2013

Okavango Delta

B/L/D

These 2 days will be spent on activities offered by the camp, including day and night game drives, walking safaris, and mokoro and boat excursions.



Okavango Delta

The very word "Okavango" evokes a sense of adventure and exploration, and this is exactly what the Okavango Delta is about. Often called the Okavango Swamps, this intricate maze of waterways and sandy islands is an explorer's dream, and the destination should be on the wishlist of anyone looking for a unique travel experience.

The geology of the Delta is fascinating, with its creation being attributed to tectonic plate action from thousands of years ago causing the Kavango River to flow from Angola into the Kalahari Desert as opposed to the Atlantic Ocean.

Day 08: 26 Feb 2013

Okavango Delta - Livingstone

B/L/D

Today you will catch a light aircraft flight out of the Delta to Kasane, where you will be met and transferred by road and boat across the border into Zambia. You will be taken to **Tongabezi** on the shores of the Zambezi River where you will spend the next **2 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**.



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Tongabezi

Tongabezi Lodge is a romantic hideaway on the banks of the Zambezi River just upstream of Victoria Falls. Their friendly team welcomes guests to a selection of houses and cottages, each beautifully styled with furniture and embellishments from all over Africa. Guests can dine beside the river or on their private terrace. Privately owned and run, Tongabezi combines an exclusive ambience with the legendary warmth and hospitality of the people of Zambia.

Day 09: 27 Feb 2013

Livingstone

B/L/D

There are numerous activities to enjoy at Tongabezi, or you can just spend the day relaxing on the banks of the Zambezi River. Included during your stay are boat cruises, canoeing, village visits, a visit to Victoria Falls (entrance fee to the Falls of US\$20 is not included and needs to be paid direct) and more.

Also included during your stay is a 15 minute helicopter flight over the Falls, named the "flight of angels" after Livingstone declared the scene so stunning that angels must choose to fly above it (park fees of US\$12 per person are not included, and needs to be paid direct).



Victoria Falls

"Mosi Oa Tunya", or "The Smoke That Thunders", Victoria Falls are as magnificent on the 10th visit as they are on the 1st, and their thundering roar makes everything else seem strangely quiet once you leave them behind. As the mighty Zambezi flows over a chasm of 1 mile wide, and 110 metres high, to violently crash on the rocks below, the resultant spray is sent tens of metres up into the air, before it lands back down in a continuous rainfall. The water then rushes through an opening of only 50 metres, as the Zambezi races further along, over churning rapids and through the Batoka Gorge.

Day 10: 28 Feb 2013

Day of departure

This morning you will be driven to the Livingstone Airport in time for your flight **SA41** back to Johannesburg, departing at **13h25** and landing at **15h10** where you will connect with your onward departure flight.

Cancellation terms and conditions:

- All cancellations must be advised of in writing
- Cancellation penalties:
 - For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
 - For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
 - For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)

Insurance:

- African Ubuntu Safaris strongly advises that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans.

Passenger Information

- Passengers should bring only soft sided bags on safaris.
- All the passengers must have Identification Card/Passport with them for internal flights.
- Baggage on internal flights is strictly limited to 20kgs per person (including hand luggage).
- Passengers travelling to Zambia need to be in a possession of a yellow fever vaccination certificate.
