CANCELLATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- ▶ All cancellations must be advised of in writing
- Cancellation penalties:
- ▶ For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
 - ▶ For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
 - ▶ For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)



INSURANCE

- ▶ African Ubuntu Safaris strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans

DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY

Day 01**13 May 2014****Arrive in Arusha**

On arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport at **20h25** on flight **PW432** you will be met after entry formalities and transferred to the **Arusha Coffee Lodge** where you will spend **1 night** on a bed and breakfast basis.

Welcome to Tanzania!

Arrive: 13 May 2014 | Depart: 14 May 2014**1 night (breakfast)**

Arusha Coffee Lodge

The Arusha Coffee Lodge is ideally placed to begin a safari in Tanzania, and offers stylish accommodation on the grounds of a coffee plantation. Comprising of 30 Plantation Houses - including 12 Plantation Suites - all of which radiate out into the evergreen coffee fields - Arusha Coffee Lodge has been designed around the original landowner's home which dates back over 100 years.

Day 02**14 May 2014****Arusha ~ Lake Manyara National Park**

This morning you will be met by your private driver-guide and driven to the Lake Manyara National Park - where you will undertake a game-drive. Late afternoon you will proceed to the Ngorongoro Crater where you will spend **2 nights** at the **Ngorongoro Crater Lodge** on a **fully inclusive basis**.

Ngorongoro Crater Lodge

Designed perfectly on the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater, the Ngorongoro Crater Lodge has been called the game lodge at the top of the world and, between the natural riches of the Crater spread out at its feet and the amazing architecture, it's easy to believe that you have entered a realm of pure fantasy. With ever-changing views as mists swirl and clouds scurry over the huge wildlife cauldron below, the location is truly breathtaking. Divided into three camps, 30 stilted suites with banana leaf ceilings and grass roofs provide an intimate and exclusive Crater experience.



Lake Manyara National Park

Being a relatively small park, and with Lake Manyara taking up the majority of the area, Lake Manyara National Park can be covered easily on half-day game drives, but these drives are usually very rewarding despite their brevity. The scenery and birdlife are Lake Manyara's major attractions, with the lake being perfectly located to offer spectacular views along the Great Rift Valley.



Ngorongoro Crater

A unique and fascinating game viewing destination, the Ngorongoro Crater is a must-see on any Tanzania safari. Being the world's largest intact caldera, and the result of a collapsed volcano thousands of years ago, the 260 square kilometres of crater floor hosts up to 25 000 animals at all times of year. This makes it one of the most dense wildlife areas in Africa, and allows for many memorable sightings.



Day 03

15 May 2014

Ngorongoro Crater

A highlight awaits you this morning as you depart to explore what is commonly referred to as the World's largest wildlife zoo. After breakfast, you descend with a picnic lunch through the early morning mists and 2,000 feet into the crater. Due to its size and diversity, the crater floor is comprised of several distinct areas, ranging from forest, swamps, lakes and springs, to open grassland and some sandy dunes. It's an awesome wildlife experience. Lunch is served near a small lake filled with hippos. You then continue game viewing before returning to the crater's rim and your lodge.

Day 04

16 May 2014

Ngorongoro Crater ~ Serengeti National Park

Leaving the Ngorongoro Crater this morning you will visit the Olduvai Gorge anthropological site before entering the Serengeti and checking in to **Serengeti Pioneer Camp** where you will spend **4 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis**. You will undertake a game drive in the National Park in the afternoon.

Serengeti Pioneer Camp

Situated in the southern Serengeti near the Moru Kopjes, the Serengeti Pioneer Camp is a throwback to the traditional 1930s style of mobile camping with regards to style and luxury. Ideally located, the camp offers you superb access to the annual wildebeest migration and the famous Big 5 which roam the endless plains, as well as stunning views of the Moru Kopjes.



Serengeti National Park

The word "Siringit" means "endless plains", and this is understandably from where the **Serengeti National Park** takes its name. The iconic, endless, golden plains of Africa are nowhere more evident than within this national park, as they stretch off into eternity, dotted throughout with thousands of animals. Located in the north-west corner of Tanzania, alongside Lake Victoria, the Serengeti has earned its place as one of the world's most famous wildlife areas.



Day 05 & 06	17 & 18 May 2014	Serengeti National Park
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These two days will be spent on morning and afternoon game drives (or full day with packed lunch) across the Serengeti plains in search of the remarkable game concentrations with the attendant predators and scavengers.

Day 07	19 May 2014	Serengeti National Park
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Early this morning you will be driven to the launch point for your **Hot-Air Balloon Safari** over the Serengeti plains. After drifting for about an hour you will land and enjoy a champagne breakfast in the wilderness, before being driven back to your lodge. The rest of the will be spent on game drives.

Day 08	20 May 2014	Serengeti National Park ~ Zanzibar
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You leave the plains of the Serengeti today by air from Seronera airstrip and fly to the island of Zanzibar, where you will be met on arrival and transferred to the **Baraza Resort & Spa** where you will spend **4 nights fully inclusive**.

Arrive: 20May 2014 | Depart: 24 May 2014 **4 nights (all meals and drinks)**
