- ▶ All cancellations must be advised of in writing
Cancellation penalties:
- ▶ For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)
- ▶ For cancellations made between 45 and 60 days prior to departure date: 50% cancellation penalty will apply
- ▶ For cancellation made less than 45 days prior to departure date: 100% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. the full booking cost)

INSURANCE

DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1**24 Jun 2014****Arrive in Johannesburg**

On arrival into Johannesburg at **16h15** today off flight **QF63 (booked by yourselves)** after passing through immigration you will be met and transferred to the **Peermont Metcourt Suites** where you will spend **1 night** on a **bed and breakfast basis**.

Arrive: 24 Jun 2014 | Depart: 25 Jun 2014**1 night (breakfast)**

Peermont Metcourt Suites

Peermont Metcourt Suites is conveniently located close to O.R. Tambo International Airport. The hotel has 80 spacious suites with contemporary furnishings. All the usual technology is provided in the rooms with Wi-Fi connectivity available in public areas. There are 56 classic suites with twin beds, 5 classic suites with king size beds, 16 deluxe suites, 2 premier suites and 2 presidential suites. Smoking and non-smoking rooms are available. Breakfast is served in the Primavera restaurant. Guests also have access to the casino, dining, entertainment, convention and relaxation facilities of the Emperors Palace resort. A regular courtesy shuttle service operates to and from the airport.

Day 2**25 Jun 2014****Johannesburg ~ Arusha**

This morning you will catch the free shuttle bus at no later than **07h24** back to the airport in time for your flight **SA184** departing for Nairobi at **10h00 (booked by yourselves)**. On landing in Nairobi at **15h15** you will wait a few hours before boarding flight **PW726** leaving at **18h00** and landing in Arusha at **19h10**. On arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport you will be met by a driver after clearing through customs and immigration and transferred to **Lake Duluti Serena Hotel**, to spend **1 night** on a **dinner, bed and breakfast basis**. Welcome to Tanzania!

Arrive: 25 Jun 2014 | Depart: 26 Jun 2014**1 night (dinner, breakfast)**

Lake Duluti Serena Hotel

Nestled at the foot of the wooded slopes of Mount Meru, the Lake Duluti Serena Hotel is situated amid coffee plantations on the shores of tranquil Lake Duluti. Designed to echo the traditional style of the colonial coffee farm, which originally existed on this site, the hotel offers a range of cottage-styled rooms set amid extensive flower gardens and lawns, featuring a stone built reception with adjoining lounge, library, elegant dining room, boutique and business centre. Additional facilities are a tented conference room, wedding planning and honeymoon venue, gift shop and WiFi.

**Day 3****26 Jun 2014****Arusha ~ Tarangire National Park**

This morning you will be collected from your lodge by your private driver-guide, who will spend the next 8 days with you, and depart Arusha for Tarangire National Park, where your wildlife experience begins. You will arrive at your camp in time for lunch, before spending the afternoon on a game drive. The next **2 nights** will be spent at **Oliver's Camp** on a **full board basis**

Arrive: 26 Jun 2014 | Depart: 28 Jun 2014**2 nights (all meals)****Oliver's Camp**

Located in the middle of the Tarangire wilderness, Oliver's Camp provides 10 guest tents scattered along the marsh edge with excellent views over the permanent water source. Each tent is covered by traditional thatch and offers an outdoor shower with indoor toilet and wash facilities. Walking safaris are the specialty of the camp. Although it is usual to get close to large mammals such as elephant, giraffe, buffalo or even lion, walking safaris are very safe as each walk is accompanied by experienced guides and an armed national park ranger. Every evening guests relax or read in the lounge and library tent, or drink sundowners at the fireplace after an exciting day in the heart of Tarangire.

Tarangire National Park

One of the best dry season parks in the region, from July through to October an enormous amount of wildlife is drawn inside Tarangire to access the water from the Tarangire River and the Silale Swamps, allowing for very rewarding game viewing experiences. The park is home to some of the largest elephant herds of East Africa, and the scenery is particularly popular for the wide open, Serengeti-like plains, decorated with enormous and commanding Baobab trees.

**Day 4****27 Jun 2014****Tarangire National Park**

Today will be spent on morning and afternoon game drives, before you are taken out in one of the camp's open sided vehicles for an exciting night drive.

Day 5**28 Jun 2014****Tarangire National Park ~ Ngorongoro Crater**

This morning you will depart Tarangire and drive to Mto Wa Mbu for a village excursion, before continuing to the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater where you will spend the next **2 nights** at the **Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge** on a **full board basis**.



Arrive: 28 Jun 2014 | Depart: 30 Jun 2014

2 nights (all meals)



Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge

Situated on the eastern rim of the Ngorongoro Crater, the 90 double bedrooms of Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge each accommodates 2 queen sized beds and a separate dressing area. Every room has a glass fronted private veranda, where you can simply relax and relish the superb view of the Crater. Lodge facilities include a glass domed reception lobby on two levels with a coffee bar area, a circular high volume dining area, a bar with 4 fireplaces, an internet café, and a gift shop.

Ngorongoro Crater

A unique and fascinating game viewing destination, the Ngorongoro Crater is a must-see on any Tanzania safari. Being the world's largest intact caldera, and the result of a collapsed volcano thousands of years ago, the 260 square kilometres of crater floor hosts up to 25 000 animals at all times of year. This makes it one of the most dense wildlife areas in Africa, and allows for many memorable sightings.



Day 6 **29 Jun 2014** **Ngorongoro Crater**

Another highlight awaits you this morning as you depart to explore what is commonly referred to as the World's largest wildlife zoo. After breakfast, you descend with a picnic lunch through the early morning mists and 2,000 feet into the crater. Due to its size and diversity, the crater floor is comprised of several distinct areas, ranging from forest, swamps, lakes and springs, to open grassland and some sandy dunes. It's an awesome wildlife experience. Your packed lunch will be served near a small lake filled with hippos after which you will continue game viewing before returning to the crater's rim and your lodge.

Day 7 **30 Jun 2014** **Ngorongoro Crater ~ Serengeti National Park**

This morning your journey will continue west, as you drive into the heart of the Serengeti National Park, where you will spend the next **2 nights** at **Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge** on a **full board basis**. En-route to the Serengeti you will stop at a Masai village, to learn a bit more about their fascinating culture.

Arrive: 30 Jun 2014 | Depart: 02 Jul 2014

2 nights (all meals)



Serengeti Sopa Lodge

Serengeti Sopa Lodge is nestled in the acacia woodland on the edge of the escarpment overlooking the plains of the south-western Serengeti National Park. Accommodation is provided in 69 standard rooms, all with 2 queen size beds, carpeted, and furnished with local fabrics and pictures. On entering the room there is a lounge with a mini bar. A veranda with 2 comfortable chairs and coffee table faces the vast Serengeti plains.



Serengeti National Park

The word "Siringit" means "endless plains", and this is understandably from where the Serengeti National Park takes its name. The iconic, endless, golden plains of Africa are nowhere more evident than within this national park, as they stretch off into eternity, dotted throughout with thousands of animals. Located in the north-west corner of Tanzania, alongside Lake Victoria, the Serengeti has earned its place as one of the world's most famous wildlife areas.

**Day 8****01 Jul 2014****Serengeti National Park**

Today will be spent on game drives exploring the central Serengeti. The location of your lodge will allow you to access a number of regions, including the wildlife rich Seronera area, and the western corridor.

Day 9**02 Jul 2014****Serengeti National Park**

This morning you will head out north, and drive up through the Serengeti towards the Kenyan border, where you will spend the next **2 nights** on a **fully inclusive basis** at **Olakira Camp**, a small mobile camp which is designed to follow the movement of the wildebeest migration. By driving up through the park, you will be following the path of the wildebeest, and give yourselves a great chance of getting amongst the mass of animals.

Arrive: 02 Jul 2014 | Depart: 04 Jul 2014**2 nights (all meals and drinks)**

Olakira Camp

Meaning "star" in Swahili, Olakira Camp aims to deliver an intimate and authentic safari experience. As the great and dramatic migration makes its way across the expansive Serengeti plains, so the luxury seasonal Olakira Camp follows. Under canvas and intimate, Olakira is made up of 8 spacious and comfortable tents. Each tent features a king size bed, en suite bathroom and private veranda. Time spent at Olakira Camp is channelled into game drives and wildlife viewing. Whether the camp is on the Mara River or the Southern Plains of Ndutu, the aim is to get as close into the thick of the action as possible. Game drives can be either half day or full day with a picnic bush lunch enjoyed overlooking the Serengeti plains.

Day 10**03 Jul 2014****Serengeti National Park**

You will have the full day to enjoy the relative solitude of the northern Serengeti, while experiencing game drives along the Mara River, hopefully being lucky enough to witness one of the famous river crossings.



Day 11

04 Jul 2014

Serengeti National Park ~ Dar es Salaam

This morning you will be driven in a camp vehicle to the Kogatende Airstrip in time for your **09h45** flight to Dar es Salaam, where you will be met on arrival at **14h20** and transferred to the **Southern Sun Dar es Salaam** where you will spend **1 night** on a **bed and breakfast** basis.

Arrive: 04 Jul 2014 | Depart: 05 Jul 2014

Southern Sun Dar es Salaam

Located in the heart of Tanzania's business capital is Southern Sun Dar es Salaam. The Hotel is in the commercial centre of the city, and it borders the Botanical Gardens and diplomatic offices. The central location of the hotel makes it a perfect choice for international business travellers, NGO's and diplomats. The hotel ambience and décor would meet the approval of the founder of Dar es Salaam, the Sultan of Zanzibar, who established the city in 1882. Room options include standard, Executive and Suites.

Day 12

05 Jul 2014

Day of Departure

This morning you will be collected early from your hotel and transferred to Dar es Salaam Airport in time for your **06h50** departure flight on **SA189** to Johannesburg (**booked by yourselves**). On arrival in Johannesburg at **09h25** you will be met after entry formalities and taken on a half day Soweto and Apartheid Museum Tour, before being dropped off at the airport again in time for flight **QF64 (booked by yourselves)** departing at **18h20** for Sydney .

Johannesburg

Although usually only used for quick stopovers by most travellers, Joburg is an exciting and vibrant city, with some excellent hotels, fantastic shopping facilities, loads of historic significance, and a flourishing sporting culture. With the launch of the Gautrain in 2010, the Sandton district is now only 10 minutes from the airport, and this puts one in a position to easily access most of the city's highlights.
