



#### CANCELLATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All cancellations must be advised of in writing <u>Cancellation penalties:</u>
- For cancellations made more than 60 days prior to start date: 30% cancellation penalty will apply (i.e. full deposit)

#### **INSURANCE**

- African Ubuntu Safaris strongly insists that every traveller purchases comprehensive travel insurance. As the deposit is non-refundable, and cancellation penalties apply, insurance must be taken out which can cover you in the event of you needing to cancel your travel plans
- African Ubuntu Safaris will not be liable for any costs resulting from any traveller's failure to purchase sufficient travel insurance

#### LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS ON LIGHT AIRCRAFT

Many itineraries include light aircraft flights. Please note that these flights have very strict luggage restrictions. Please take note of the following:

#### **East Africa:**

- Bags must be completely soft sided. At present, bags with frames and wheels are accepted, provided the rest of the bag is soft.
- The weight limit is 15 kg per person. This includes hand luggage.
- Extra weight allowance can be purchased in advance.

If your bags do not fit the requirements, you may be asked to purchase a suitable bag from the airline and repack your belongings into this.

#### **DETAILED DAILY ITINERARY**

Day 1

06 Oct 2014

**Arrive in Serengeti National Park** 

You will make your own way to the **Kigali International Airport** for your **Coastal Aviation Flight** (US\$38.00 Per Person Departure Tax to be paid on the ground) departing at **o6hoo** from Kigali to the Kogatende Airstrip in the Northern Part of the Serengeti National Park. The flight will make several 'hops,' one being in Mwanza for clearing Immigration & Customs. Upon arrival at the Kogatende Airstrip at approximately **9h45** you will be met and transferred (with game-viewing en-route) to **Ubuntu Camp**. You will spend **o3 Nights** at **Ubuntu Camp** in close proximity to the Mara River on a **Fully Inclusive** Basis.

Arrive: 06 Oct 2014 | Depart: 09 Oct 2014

3 nights (all meals and drinks)



#### **Ubuntu Camp**

Ubuntu Camp is a mobile luxury tented camp which follows the natural flow of the wildebeest through the Serengeti eco-system. From August to November the camp is perfectly positioned in a new campsite to intercept the same animals as they arrive in the north. Each tent is either a double or twin (triples available), with flush toilets and running water in en-suite bathrooms. Hospitality, great food, and a wonderful relaxed environment is the essence of Ubuntu Camp.



# **Serengeti National Park**

The word "Siringit" means "endless plains", and this is understandably from where the Serengeti National Park takes its name. The iconic, endless, golden plains of Africa are nowhere more evident than within this national park, as they stretch off into eternity, dotted throughout with thousands of animals. Located in the north-west corner of Tanzania, alongside Lake Victoria, the Serengeti has earned its place as one of the world's most famous wildlife areas.



Day 2 & 3

07 & 08 Oct 2014

Serengeti National Park

For these two days you will participate in daily scheduled game-drives in an open-sided camp 4WD Vehicle inside the Serengeti National Park. Early in the morning of **o8 October** you will be driven to the launch point for your **Hot-Air Balloon Safari** over the Serengeti plains. After drifting for about an hour you will land and enjoy a champagne breakfast in the wilderness, before being driven back to camp.

Day 4

09 Oct 2014

Serengeti National Park ~ Ngorongoro Crater

A morning game drive will take you to the Kogatende Airstrip for your **Regional Air Flight** leaving at **10h00** for the Manyara Airstrip. On arrival at approximately **11h35**, you will be met by your Naturalist Driver-Guide in a Private 4WD Vehicle and undertake a Game Drive in the Lake Manyara National Park before proceeding to the Ngorongoro Highlands. You will spend **02 Nights** at the **Exploreans Ngorongoro Lodge** on a **Full Board** Basis.

Arrive: 09 Oct 2014 | Depart: 11 Oct 2014

2 nights (all meals)



# **Exploreans Ngorongoro Lodge**

Exploreans Ngorongoro Lodge is a log cabin-style retreat in the Ngorongoro volcanic landscape. Accommodation consists of 20 luxury en suite cottages with open fire places in the bedrooms and living rooms, and large private viewing terraces with sofas and dining areas. Facilities include a kingsize canopy bed, large shower, 2 hand wash basins, private toilet, and in-room safe, as well as a butler on call. The formal dining room features an outdoor terrace where Mediterranean cuisine is fused with local dishes. Pool and bush dinners as well as sundowner cocktails can be reserved in dedicated areas around the lodge and also enjoyed around campfires.

# Lake Manyara National Park

Being a relatively small park, and with Lake Manyara taking up the majority of the area, Lake Manyara National Park can be covered easily on half-day game drives, but these drives are usually very rewarding despite their brevity. The scenery and birdlife are Lake Manyara's major attractions, with the lake being perfectly located to offer spectacular views along the Great Rift Valley.





### **Ngorongoro Crater**

A unique and fascinating game viewing destination, the Ngorongoro Crater is a must-see on any Tanzania safari. Being the world's largest intact caldera, and the result of a collapsed volcano thousands of years ago, the 260 square kilometres of crater floor hosts up to 25 000 animals at all times of year. This makes it one of the most dense wildlife areas in Africa, and allows for many memorable sightings.



Day 5 10 Oct 2014 Ngorongoro Crater

A highlight awaits you this morning as you descend with a picnic lunch 2,000 feet into the crater. Due to its size and diversity, the crater floor is comprised of several distinct areas, ranging from forest, swamps, lakes and springs, to open grassland and some sandy dunes. It's an awesome wildlife experience. A picnic lunch is served overlooking a small lake populated with hippos. You return to the lodge in the late afternoon.

Day 6 11 Oct 2014 Ngorongoro Crater ~ Pemba

After a leisurely breakfast your guide will drive you to the Manyara Airstrip (with a packed lunch) for your **Coastal Aviation Flight** leaving at **11h25** for Pemba Island. On arrival at the Chake Chake Airport at approximately **15h05**, you will be met and transferred to **Fundu Lagoon**. You will spend **03 Nights** at **Fundu Lagoon** on a **Fully Inclusive** Basis.

Arrive: 11 Oct 2014 | Depart: 14 Oct 2014 3 nights (all meals and drinks)



# **Fundu Lagoon**

Fundu Lagoon is on the tropical island of Pemba, which is part of the Zanzibar archipelago. The hotel is situated on a remote and beautiful beach on the south western side of Pemba, and is only accessible by boat. There are 18 en suite rooms, consisting of canvas tents set under makuti (thatch) roofs on wooden decks, all with views over the sea. The rooms are equipped with large double or twin beds, mosquito nets, fans, safes, fridges, and indoor and outdoor seating areas. The rooms are connected to the main buildings by wooden walkways or paths through indigenous forest. Some rooms are situated along the beachfront and the remaining on the hillside, which have wide views over the lagoon. The main hotel is built under thatch and is large and airy with a view of the ocean.

# Zanzibar

The Zanzibar Archipelago has lured travellers to its pristine, white beaches for centuries. The main island of Zanzibar (correctly named Unguja), has a plethora of accommodation options, ranging from rustic beach bungalows to large and glitzy resorts, and can offer something to everyone's taste. Sandy beaches run the length of the coast, shaded by green palm trees, and caressed by turquoise waters.





Day 7 & 8 12 & 13 Oct 2014 Pemba

These two full days will be spent at leisure, enjoying some of the numerous activities available on the Island or just relaxing on the beach or at the pool with a cocktail.

Day 9 14 Oct 2014 Pemba ~ Stone Town

After a leisurely morning you will be transferred back to the Chake Chake Airport for your Coastal Aviation Flight leaving at 12h15 to Zanzibar Island. On arrival at the Zanzibar Airport at approximately 12h45, you will be met and transferred to the Zanzibar Serena Inn. You will spend 01 Night at the Zanzibar Serena Inn on a Bed & Breakfast basis. You will have the afternoon free to explore Stone Town (on own arrangements).

Arrive: 14 Oct 2014 | Depart: 15 Oct 2014

#### Zanzibar Serena Inn

Idyllically situated on the sea-front of ancient Stone Town, and flanked by an exotic mix of sultan's palaces, Portuguese forts, ancient dhow harbours, and bright bazaars, the Zanzibar Serena Inn is a haven of tranquillity and opulence amongst the bustle of one of Africa's most ancient and most enchanting towns. A member of the prestigious Small Luxury Hotels of the World, the inn has been styled to represent the epitome of Swahili style, ethnic elegance and Arabic opulence. Adorned with arched niches, antique plates and brass lamps, and featuring traditionally carved furniture with basket weave and ceramic inlay, the rooms are predominantly royal blue and white.

#### **Stone Town**

The capital of Zanzibar is Zanzibar Town, in which Stone Town is a bustling, energetic and fascinating ancient part. With narrow mazes as streets, and intricately carved doors decorating the white-washed buildings, Stone Town invites you to explore its inner zones, and many an hour can be spent taking it all in. The sights and sounds, and the spicy smells, somehow remind you of a time long ago, and on exiting the web of alleys you feel as if you have left behind another world in another age.



Day 10 15 Oct 2014 Stone Town ~ Nairobi

After breakfast check out of your room by latest 10h00. You will have the morning free to explore Stone Town (on own arrangements). At approximately 13h45 you will be transferred the Zanzibar Airport for your International Flight PW #713 leaving Zanzibar at 16h40 for Kenya. After landing at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi at approximately 18h20, you will be met and transferred to The Boma Hotel to spend 01 Night on a Bed & Breakfast Basis.

#### The Boma Hotel

The Boma Hotel consists of 148 luxury guest rooms, in a variety of different categories. An executive lounge is available for guests staying in deluxe rooms and suites. All rooms and suites come with luxury amenities including complimentary high-speed Internet access, multimedia plug and play port, LED television, direct dial up telephone, and have access to 24 hour room service. Also provided are hairdryers, mini bars, tea and coffee making facilities, mineral water, weighing scales, in room safes, black out curtains, double glazed windows, and laundry kits.

#### Nairobi

Kenya's capital city has risen from a highland swampland called Ewaso Nai'beri – the place of cold – by the local Masai. When railway workers reached this area in 1899, they set up a basic camp and supply depot. The camp became a rustic village, and then a shanty town, which by 1907 was the capital of all of British East Africa. It was soon an important centre for the colony and a mecca for adventurers, hunters and travellers from all over the world. Modern Nairobi is still the safari capital of the Africa, and has become one of Africa's largest and most interesting cities.



Day 11 16 Oct 2014 Day of Departure

On this last day of your stay you will check out by latest 10h00. Around midday you will be transferred by road to the **Jomo Kenyatta International Airport** for your **International Flight SA #185** (Booked as per own Arrangements) departing at **16h05**.
